## DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Do not use this product in or on electrical equipment due to the possibility of shock hazard.

Do not use in food areas of food handling establishments, restaurants or other areas where food is commercially prepared or propessed. Do not use in serving areas while food is exposed or facility is in operation. Serving areas are areas where prepared foods are served such as dining rooms but excluding areas where food may be prepared or held. In the home, all food processing surfaces and utensits should be covered during during treatment, or thoroughly washed before reuse. Exposed food should be covered or removed.

Nonfeed aleas are areas tuch as garbage rooms, lavatories, floor drains (to sewers), entries and vestibules, offices, locker rooms, machine rooms, boiler rooms, garages, mop closets and storage (after canning or bottling).

### SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING

Remove protective cap, hold container upright and spray from a distance of 12 to 15 inches.

Remove birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying.

Housefiles, Mosquitoes, Gnats, Wasps, Hornets, Bees, Blow Files and Small Flying Moths: Close all doors and windows and spray room at the rate of 2 to 3 seconds per 1000 cubic feet. Direct spray to all parts of the room, especially windows and other light sources which attract these insects. Keep nozzle in constant motion. Repeat treatment as necessary.

Cockroaches, Waterbugs, Palmetto Bugs, Silvertish, Firebrats, Crick J., Scorpions, Spiders, Millipedes, Centipedes, Sowbugs and Pillbugs: Spray Into hiding places such as cracks and crevices, behind sinks, cabinets, along baseboards and floors, around drains and plumbing, hitting insects with spray whenever possible. Repeat treatment as necessary.

Anta: Spray trails, nests and points of entry, Spray on ants where possible. Repeat as necessary

Indian Meal Moths, Angoumois Grain Moths: Close doors and windows, direct spray into all parts of room especially around stored food product containers, pallets and darkened areas, Spray 7 to 10 seconds for each 1000 cubic feet of space. Keep area closed for 15 minutes following treatment. Repeat application as necessary.

Exposed stages of Confused Flour Beetles, Saw-Toothed Grain Beetles, Red Flour Beetles, Rice Weevils, Grains Weevils, Grain Mites: Spray into cracks and crevices, processing and handling equipment, around cartons or containers or other areas where these insects tend to congregate. Spray 30 seconds for each 100 square feet of surface. Keep area closed for 45

minutes to 1 hour after treatment. Repeat application as necessary, Infested stored food products in the home should be disposed of.

Carpet Beetles: Spray directly on beetles, floors, baseboards, shelves and carpets: Repeat treatment as necessary.

Bedbugs: Spray mattresses, particularly around tufts and seams. Take beds apart and spray into all joints. Treat baseboards, moldings and floors. Repeat treatment as necessary. Allow all sprayed articles to dry thoroughly before use.

To control Clothes Moths: Remove any infested articles from storage, brush thoroughly, and air for several hours in sunlight, if possible. Apply spray liberally to empty chests, closets, bureaus and other storages directing the spray into cracks, joints and crevices. After airing, infested articles may be treated lightly keeping nozzle at least three feet from fabric to avoid staining. Allow all sprayed articles to dry thoroughly before use.

In enimel quarters and milk rooms: For rapid control of House Files, Mosquitoes, Gnats, Wasps, Homets, Bees and Small Ftying Moths, close windows and doors and spray at the rate of 2 seconds per 1000 cubic feet of space. For best results, keep area closed for 10 minutes after spraying. Do not remain in treated area and ventilate after treatment is completed.

To treat Ilvestock: To protect beef cattle, dairy cattle, goats, sheep, hogs and horses from attacks of Stable Files, Horse Files, Deer Files, Face Files, House Files, Hom Files, Mosquitoes, and Gnats: Spray about 3 seconds on each side being careful to spray back, withers and forelegs thoroughly. To protect from face flies, spray the face and head, but do not spray into eyes. Repeat treatment when flies are troublesome.

For Swine: Do not ship animals for slaughter within 5 days of last treatment.

To control *Blood Sucking Lice:* Apply to the infested areas of the animal, using a stiff brush to get the spray to the base of the hair. Repeat every 3 weeks if required.

To control *Poultry Lice*, spray roosts, walls and nests or cages thoroughly. This should be followed by spraying over the birds with a line mist.

For control of Bedbugs and Miles In Fultry houses, spray crevices of nost poles, cracks in walls, and cracks in nests where the bedbugs and miles hide.

Fless and Ticks: (Adults and Larvae): Remove and thoroughly
 člešn or riestrog pet Bedding. Spray pet sier ping quarters, bed,
 entire floor and floorcoverings with special attention to cracks and
 crevices around baseboards, and window and door frames. Infested upholstered furniture may also be treated with this product. A test application should be made to upholstery or drapery fabrics in an inconspicuous place before use.
