2. The upgraded acute inhalation limit test (submitted 2/11/91) and the previous acute inhalation study, when reviewed together, are core-minimum and therefore acceptable to support the product registration. Please note that neither study would ~~not~~ be acceptable individually. In the future, we will not accept studies conducted in this manner. Enclosed is a copy of the review for your reference.

1-[cyclohexene-1,2-dicarboximido] methyl 2,2-dimethyl-3-(2-methyl-propenyl) cyclopropanecarboxylate

- c. Correct the spelling of "propylpiperonyl" in the footnotes.

- d. Correct the spelling in chemical name for Permethrin as follows:

"...2,2-dimethylcyclopropanecarboxylate."

- e. The cis/trans ratio should be as follows:

min. 35%(±) cis and max. 65%(±) trans.

- f. Revise/add to the Environmental Hazards section as follows:

This product is extremely toxic to fish and aquatic invertebrates. Do not apply directly to any body of water.

- g. Under the IF INHALED statement, add the statement "Get medical attention."

- h. With regards to the language of the flammability statement, refer to the Federal Register Notice (56 FR 6856, February 20, 1991) regarding pesticide aerosol flammability.

4. Submit five copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 Enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING

Point spray nozzle away from face. Hold can on slight downward angle. For best results, spray when air is calm. Allow a few minutes for product to take effect. Spray with wind if slight breeze is blowing (i.e. under 5 mph).

Flying Insects: Flies, Mosquitoes, Gnats, Small Flying Moths, Hornets and Yellow Jackets Allow fog to drift over area. Direct spray toward bushes, or grass from at least 4 to 6 feet away. Give special attention to breeding areas such as garbage cans, compost piles. Repeat as necessary.

Crawling Insects: Ants, Cockroaches, including Asian Cockroaches, Crickets, Centipedes, and Silverfish. Spray infested surface of patio or picnic area, hitting as many insects as possible. Also spray legs of tables and chairs to repel ants. Sprayant hills for best control. Keep 4 to 6 feet away from ornamental plants while spraying.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry area inaccessible to children.

DISPOSAL: Wrap container and discard in trash. Do not puncture or incinerate.
