

PyraPerm[™] Dusting Powder provides efficience control of pests in_ and on buildings and structures and their immediate surroundings and on modes of transport. Permitted areas of use include, but are not limited to; private residences, stores, warehouses, hotels, industrial buildings, apartment buildings, mausoleums, laboratories, schools, non-patient areas of nursing homes and hospitals, and in nontood areas of; restaurants, food manufacturing, processing and servicing establishments, and on; vessels, rail cars, aircraft, buses, trucks and trailers.

PyraPerm[™] Dusting Powder provides quick killing action and long lasting control of fleas and ticks on dogs.

PyraPerm¹⁶Dusting Powder is intended for application using hand or power duster or by other suitable means, to hiding and runway areas and those places where pests are found. For application directly into cracks and crevices, a bulbous duster or other suitable equipment may be used. Apply lightly and uniformly to infested areas. Pay particular attention to: cracks and crevices; service ducts; around electrical and telephone fittings and equipment; around water and sewer pipes; under and behind cabinets; refrigerators and sinks; around window and door frames; and along baseboards. Wear protective clothing if deemed necessary to avoid stings. Using hand or power duster or other suitable means, with extension tubes if necessary, thoroughly dust nest and entrance and surrounding areas where insects light. Nests in wall voids can be located by listening with your ear against the wall. Orill a hole in the area, blow dust in, and reseal. For ground wasps, dust entrance and surrounding areas. For best results check nests carefully one or two days after treatment to ensure complete kill, then remove and destroy nest to prevent emergence of newty-hatched insects. If removal is not feasible, retreat the nest, if necessary. Do not use this product to treat overhead nests.

Webbing Clothes Moths: Use this product as a crack and crevice treatment in closets and other storage areas where these pests are found. This is an adjunct treatment and will not control moth larvae already on the clothes. Do not apply to clothing.

<u>FOOD_HANDLING_ESTABLISHMENTS</u> - Places other than private residences in which food is held, processed, prepared or erved.

PERIMETER TREATMENT; Use PyraPerm¹⁴ Dusting Powder as a residual treatment for control of Ants, Bees, Brown Dog Ticks, Centipedes, Cockrosches, Crickets, Earwigs, Firebrats, Fless, Ground Beetles, Millipsdes, Pillbugs, Scorpions, Silverlish, Sowbugs, Spiders, Ticks and Wasps. Make a residual treatment around windows and doors, porches, screens, eaves, patios, garages, under stairways and in crawl spaces and other areas where pests hide.

To help prevent invasion of buildings and structures by the above pests, treat a band of soil and vegetation 6 to 10 feet wide around and adjacent to the building or structure at a rate of 3 to 6 ounces per 100 square feet. Also treat the building foundation and crawl spaces where pests are active and may find entrance. Apply thoroughly and uniformly to the band area. Pay particular attention to ant hills and wasp nests in the band area. Wasp and bee nests in trees and shrubs may be treated as noted above.

<u>Cockrosches in Sewers:</u> Apply 6 oz. of PyraPerm¹⁴ Dusting Powder per manhole using a power duster for knockdown and short-term population suppression. Where longer residual control (30 days) is desired, apply 10 oz. of PyraPerm¹⁴ Dusting Powder per manhole.
