2. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment:

 - b. According to PR Notice 83-3 all aerosol products must bear the following statement under Storage and Disposal: "Do not incinerate or puncture."
 - c. In our registration notice dated September 12, 1990 for TetraPerm Dual Action Ant and Roach Killer (EPA Reg. No. 4816-729), we inadvertently misclassified the product as a "non-sensitizer." Since acute toxicology studies for EPA Reg. No. 4816-729 also support Tetraperm Crawling Insect Killer, the following must appear under **Precautionary Statements:**

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

GENERAL INFORMATION: TetraPerm™ Professional Strength Crawling Insect Killer provides effective control of pests in and on buildings and structures and their immediate surroundings and on modes of transport. Permitted areas of use include, but are not limited to: apartment buildings, homes, hospitals, hotels, industrial buildings, laboratories, mausoleums, motels, nursing homes, private residences, schools, stores, utilities, warehouses, and in nonfood areas of: restaurants, food manufacturing, processing and servicing establishments, and on: vessels, rail cars, aircraft, buses, trucks and trailers.

Do not use in the edible product areas of food/feed processing plants, restaurants or other areas where food/feed is commercially prepared or served. Do not use in serving areas while food is exposed.

Hold container upright with nozzle away from you. Press valve down and spray as directed. Spray surface until slightly wet (at a rate of 4 ounces product to treat approximately 25 square feet of surface area).

Ants: Spray freely around ant trails, doors and windows, and other places where ants enter premises around nests hidden under steps, brickwork, concrete, etc. Break apart accessible nests and spray freely on and around debris. Repeat as necessary.

Carpenter Ants: For effective control, locate and treat nests and surrounding areas. Apply around doors and windows and other places where ants enter premises and where they crawl and hide. Spray into infested wood through existing openings or newly drilled small holes.

Brown Dog Ticks and Fleas in Buildings: Apply to infested areas such as pet beds and resting quarters, nearby cracks and crevices, under the edges of rugs and floor coverings, between and under cushions of upholstered furniture and other areas where these pests may be present. Old bedding of pets should be removed and replaced with clean fresh bedding after treatment of pet areas.
