For protection against mosquitoes and ticks from the wind, spray outer surfaces of clothing and mosquito netting with a slow sweeping motion over the fabric. Treat the clothing for a minimum of 2 hours (4 hours under humid conditions) and allow 2 hours (4 hours under humid conditions) to dry. Can be used at a distance of 6 to 8 inches from the object. Moisten the surface of the fabric enough to cover it. Use approximately 3/4 of this container to treat the remainder on mosquito netting.

Treat the entire outside surface of clothing and trouser cuffs, and shirt cuffs. Part cuffs shoes and footwear to ensure full protection against ticks. Use in conjunction with the standard issue repellent to exposed skin areas to achieve maximum protection. Standard field uniform laundering procedures and sixth laundering.
