For protection against *Mosquitoes of genus Anopheles*, protect from the wind, spray outer surfaces of mosquito netting with a slow sweeping motion. Treat the clothing for a minimum of 30 seconds (under humid conditions) to dry prior to being worn. Treat the clothing from the object being treated. Treatment should be enough to cause a slight color change. Use appropriate amount to treat one complete field uniform. Use remainder on

Treat the entire outside surface of clothing with repellent. Treat shirt cuffs. Pant cuffs should be worn inside. For protection against *Ticks* and *Chiggers*. This is a standard issue repellent approved for application. For maximum protection from *Mosquitoes of genus Anopheles*, laundering procedures weekly. Reapply after

STORAGE AND

Store in original container in a cool dry place in a well-ventilated area. Protect from heat or open flame.

Replace cap, wrap container in several layers of plastic. Do not incinerate or puncture. In field situations bury
