After reviewing our records again, we conclude the product is a sensitizer and therefore a statement is required.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

One 6 ounce aerosol can treats up to 6,000 cubic feet of unobstructed area (a room 30' x 25' with an 8 foot ceiling).

For *Fleas* and *Ticks*, use one 6 ounce can for every 1,500 cubic feet of room space.

One 12 ounce aerosol can treats up to 12,000 cubic feet of unobstructed area (a room 50' x 30' with an 8 foot ceiling).

PRECAUTIONS:

Do not use in food/feed areas of food/feed handling establishments, restaurants or other areas where food/feed is commercially prepared or processed. Do not use in serving areas while food is exposed or facility is in operation. Serving areas are areas where prepared foods are served such as dining rooms but excluding areas where foods may be prepared or held.

In the home, cover all food handling surfaces and cover or remove all food and cooking utensils, or wash thoroughly after treatment. Exposed food should be covered or removed.

Non-food/feed areas of food/feed establishments are areas such as garbage rooms, lavatories, floor drains (to sewers entries and vestibules), offices, locker rooms, machine rooms, boiler rooms, garages, mop closets and storage (after canning or bottling).

HOW TO USE:

Step 1: PREPARATION

Open cupboards, cabinets, trunks, and doors to area to be treated to allow maximum kill in all areas where insects can hide and breed. Close outside doors and windows and shut off fans and air conditioning to maximize killing power of fog. Remove pets, birds, and tightly cover or remove fish bowls and aquariums before spraying. Remove or cover exposed foods, dishes, utensils or food handling equipment. All food processing surfaces should be covered during treatment or thoroughly cleaned before using. Shut off electrical appliances. Do not place activated fogger in a cabinet or under a counter or table.

Step 2: ACTIVATION

SHAKE WELL JUST BEFORE USE. Turn cap to activate fogger. Place newspaper on a level surface in center of room to within 6 feet of pilot lights. Turn fogger on and depress tab firmly with thumb. Aiming spray at newspaper, leave room and leave room or house at once before airing out. Open all windows to air for 30 minutes. Repeat when necessary.

STORAGE:

STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry place away from children and pets and away from open flame.

DISPOSAL: Replace cap. Do not puncture newspaper and discard in a puncture.

PRECAUTIONS: HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

Avoid contact with eyes. If contact occurs, flush eyes with plenty of water. If irritation persists, consult a physician.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS:

Contents under pressure. Do not puncture. Do not place on stove or radiator. Do not heat above 130°F may cause explosion.

IMPORTANT! To avoid explosion, use as follows:

- ‡ Only one can per room.
- ‡ Do not place in cabinet.
- ‡ Shut off electrical equipment.
- ‡ Place can at least 6 feet from any electrical equipment.
