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- c. Revise the food handling precautionary statement by adding the word feed to the current language, i.e.:
- ". . use in food/feed areas . ."
 - ". . where food/feed is commercially . ."
 - ". . non-food/feed areas are areas such . ."
- d. Use in food handling establishments can imply use in the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) Meat and Poultry Plants. Therefore, either add the statement "Not for Use in USDA Meat and Poultry Plants" or submit an application to USDA requesting these areas. If granted you can then indicate on the label that the product can be used in these areas.
- e. The claim for controlling ticks which may cause Lyme disease is unsupported. Submit/cite data supporting this claim or delete from label.

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DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Do not use in food areas of food handling establishments, restaurants or other areas where food is commercially prepared or processed. Do not use in serving areas while food is exposed or facility is in operation. Serving areas are areas where prepared foods are served such as dining rooms but excluding areas where foods may be prepared or held.

In the home, all food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment or thoroughly washed before use. Exposed food should be covered or removed.

Nonfood areas are areas such as garbage rooms, lavatories, floor drains (to sewers), entries and vestibules, offices, locker rooms, machine rooms, boiler rooms, garages, mop closets and storage (after canning or bottling).

SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING. Remove protective cap, hold container upright and spray from a distance of 12 to 15 inches. Remove birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying.

INDOORS:

Cockroaches, Waterbugs, Palmetto Bugs, Silverfish, Firebrats, Crickets, Scorpions, Spiders, Millipedes, Centipedes, Sowbugs and Pillbugs: Spray into hiding places such as cracks and crevices, behind sinks, cabinets, along baseboards and floors, around drains and plumbing, hitting insects with spray whenever possible. Repeat treatment as necessary.

Ants: Spray trails, nests and points of entry. Spray on ants where possible. Repeat as necessary.

Exposed stages of Confused Flour Beetles, Sawtoothed Grain Beetles, Red Flour Beetles, Rice Weevils, Granary Weevils, Grain Mites: Spray into cracks and crevices, processing and handling equipment, around cartons or containers or other areas where these insects tend to congregate. Spray 3 seconds for each 10 square feet of surface. Keep area closed for 45 minutes to 1 hour after treatment. Repeat application as necessary. Infested stored food products in the home should be disposed of.

Carpet Beetles: Spray directly on beetles, floors, baseboards, shelves and carpets. Repeat treatment as necessary.

Bed Bugs: Spray mattresses, particularly around tufts and seams. Take beds apart and spray into all joints. Treat baseboards, moldings and floors. Repeat treatment as necessary.

To control **Clothes Moths** and **Carpet Beetles** on wool and other proteinaceous fibers: Remove infested articles from storage,

brush thoroughly, and air for several minutes. Apply spray liberally to empty chest drawers, closets, storage containers, etc. directing the spray into cracks and crevices. Infested articles may be treated by spraying with nozzle at least three feet from fabric.

OUTDOOR:

Point spray nozzle away from face and eyes. For best results, spray with nozzle at least three feet from fabric. Blow air over treated areas for several minutes for product to take effect.

PESTS ON OUTSIDE SURFACE: For building infestation due to **Ants, Earwigs, Millipedes** and **Sowbugs** (termites) in building where insects are active at height of 2 to 3 feet. Apply as a residual treatment to exterior surfaces of buildings where insects tend to congregate (but are not limited to) screen porches, patios, garages and refuse areas. Repeat treatment as necessary.

CRAWLING INSECTS: **Ants, Cockroaches, Crickets, Centipedes, Millipedes, Spiders, Sowbugs and Pillbugs:** Spray infested surface of patio or picnic area. Repeat treatment as necessary. Also spray legs of tables and chairs. Repeat treatment as necessary. ant hills for best control.

Ants, Ticks which may cause Lyme Disease and Earwigs: Apply thoroughly to lawns and gardens. For ants, spray freely around ant hills for best control.

Store in a cool, dry area. Do not store in areas where children or pets can access.
