2. Make the labeling change listed below before you release the product for shipment:

- a. Add the phrase, "EPA Registration No. 4816-752."
- b. We have determined that the subject product and 4816-TLE (Tetramer Insect Killer N104 WBA) are substantially similar and that acute toxicity data may be bridged. Therefore your product is a toxicity category III for inhalation and your labeling's Precautionary Statements and Statement of Practical Treatment must reflect this. Under Statement of Practical Treatment add:

IF ON SKIN: Wash with plenty of soap and water. Get medical attention.

IF IN EYES: Flush with plenty of water. Call a physician if irritation persists.

IF INHALED: Remove victim to fresh air. If not breathing give artificial respiration, preferably mouth to mouth. Get medical attention.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

In the home, all food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment or thoroughly washed before use. Exposed food should be covered or removed.

SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING

Remove protective cap, hold container upright and spray from a distance of 12 to 15 inches. Remove birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying.

INDOORS:

Houseflies, Fruit Flies, Mosquitoes, Gnats, Wasps, Hornets, Bees, Black Flies, Skipper Flies, Blow Flies and Small Flying Moths: Close all doors and windows and direct spray upward into center of room with a slow sweeping motion. Spray 5-10 seconds for average room. Direct spray to all parts of the room, especially windows and other light sources which attract these insects. Keep nozzle in constant motion. Keep room closed for 15 minutes after spraying. Ventilate room thoroughly before re-entry. Sweep up and discard fallen insects. Repeat treatment as necessary.

Cockroaches, Waterbugs, Palmto Bugs, Silverfish, Firebrats, Crickets, Scorpions, Spiders, Millipedes, Centipedes, Sowbugs and Pillbugs: Spray into hiding places such as cracks and crevices, behind sinks, cabinets, along baseboards and floors, around drains and plumbing, hitting insects with spray whenever possible. Repeat treatment as necessary.

Ants: Spray trails, nests and points of entry. Spray on ants where possible. Repeat as necessary.

Carpet Beetles: Spray directly on beetles, floors, baseboards, shelves and carpets. Repeat treatment as necessary.

Bedbugs: Spray mattresses, particularly around tufts and seams. Take beds apart and spray into all joints. Treat baseboards, moldings and floors. Repeat treatment as necessary.

To control **Clothes Moths** and **Carpet Beetles** on wool and other proteinaceous fibers: Remove infested articles from storage, brush thoroughly, and air for several hours in sunlight, if possible. Apply spray liberally to empty chests, closets, bureaus and other storages directing the spray into cracks, joints and crevices. After airing, infested articles may be treated by spraying lightly, keeping nozzle at least three feet from fabric to avoid staining.

OUTDOORS:

Point spray nozzle away from face. Hold can on slight downward angle. For best results, spray when air is calm.

Allow a few minutes for product to dry.
If breeze is blowing.

Pests On Outside Surface: Spray on outside surface of building infestation due to **Earwigs, Millipedes**, and **Centipedes** on building where entrance, up to a height of 6 feet, to outside surface of building. Spray areas including window frames, eaves, porches, and dumps. Repeat treatment as necessary.

FLYING INSECTS: **Flies, Moths, Hornets** and **Yellowjackets**. Direct spray toward insects from a distance of 6 feet away. Give special attention to garbage cans and compost piles.

CRAWLING INSECTS: **Cockroaches, Crickets, Silverfish.** Spray infestation area, hitting as many insects as possible. Use on floors and chairs to repel ants.

Ants, Lone Star Ticks, etc. Spray thoroughly to infestation area. **Ants**, spray freely around infestation.

For the Control of Ornamental Plants: Spray dahlias, asters and other plants hit by spray, as well as **Spiders, Red Mites** and **Earwigs**.

May be used on plants in small gardens and for spot treatments to prevent spread. May be used on other plants such as **azaleas, begonias, canterburys, dahlias, delphiniums, daisies, chias, geraniums, crassulaceas, marigolds, rhododendrons, stocks, wandering Jews**.

Effective when used as **Spider and Red Mite** control. **Japanese Beetles, Pear Thrips, Worms.** When spraying, use sweeping motion. Use sweeping motion. Be cautious about wetting plants. Do not spray plants in contact with insects directly as infestations occur.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Store in a cool, dry area. Do not transport or store below 32°F. Wrap container in several layers of newspaper and dispose of in trash. Do not incinerate or puncture.
