IF ON SKIN: Wash with plenty of soap and water. medical attention.

IF INHALED: Remove victim to fresh air. breathing give artificial respiration, preferably mouth to mouth. Get medical attention.

d. Revise Precautionary Statements as follows:

"Harmful if absorbed through skin or inhaled. Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing. Avoid breathing vapor or spray mist. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before smoking or eating. Avoid contamination of feed . . ."

- e. On the front panel delete ". . . and many other pests."

 Vague and non-specific terminology is not allowed. You
 may use, ". . . and many similar pests."
- f. Add a footnote to the inert ingredients indicating:

*Contains petroleum distillates

g. The label is not clear as to where the product can be used. We assume it is for residential use thus on the front panel add:

"For Use In and Around the Home"

h. Include the claim Deer Ticks in parenthesis following the general tick claim, i.e.:

Ticks (including deer tick)

- i. Delete the paragraph beginning "May be used on plants as well . . ." since it is redundant with the first and third paragraphs under For the Control of Garden Insects.
- j. On the front and side panels add ornamental before garden insects, i.e., ". . . residential and ornamental insects"; ". . . Control of Ornamental Garden Insects."
- 3. We are currently rereviewing your Skin Sensitization (MRID No.'s 417621-05 and 417456-06) and Skin Irritation (MRID No.'s 417621-04 and 417456-05). Both set of studies are identical and were twice submitted, reviewed, and assigned MRID numbers. studies (Report No.'s 6986-90 and T-9892 respectively) were submitted in support of the subject product and Tetraperm Insect Killer WBA. The Skin Sensitization and Skin Irritation study supporting Tetraperm Insect Killer WBA were graded non-sensitizer (core guideline) and toxicity category IV (core guideline) respectively. The same studies supporting Tetraperm Indoor Flying Insect Killer WBA were graded supplementary and toxicity category (core guideline) respectively. Toxicity data from the substantially similar product TetraPerm (0.15 - 0.15 - 0.75) Yard & Patio WBA will be used for this product. Therefore this product is a non-sensitizer and toxicity category III for skin irritation. When the discrepancy between the studies is resolved we will inform you.

- 4. Efficacy data supporting deer tick claims submitted September 30, 1992 and January 6, 1993 are acceptable.
- 5. Your Confidential Statement of Formula does not reflect the nominal concentration of the active ingredients. Please submit a revised CSF. See PR Notice 91-2 and 40 CFR §158.175 for more information.
- 6. Submit five copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 Enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

In the home, all food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment or thoroughly washed before use. Exposed food should be covered or removed.

SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING

Remove protective cap, hold container upright and spray from a distance of 12 to 15 inches. Remove birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying.

INDOORS:

Houseflies, Fruit Files, Mosquitoes, Gnats, Wasps, Hornets, Bees, Black Files, Skipper Files, Blow Files and Small Flying Moths: Close all doors and windows and direct spray upward into center of room with a slow sweeping motion. Spray 5-10 seconds for average room. Direct spray to all parts of the room, especially windows and other light sources which attract these insects. Keep nozzle in constant motion. Keep room closed for 15 minutes after spraying. Ventilate room thoroughly before re-entry. Sweep up and discard fallen insects. Repeat treatment as necessary.

Cockroaches, Waterbugs, Palmetto Bugs, Silverfish, Firebrats, Crickets, Scorpions, Spiders, Millipedes, Centipedes, Sowbugs and Pillbugs: Spray Into hiding places such as cracks and crevices, behind sinks, cabinets, along baseboards and floors, around drains and plumbing, hitting insects with spray whenever possible. Repeat treatment as necessary.

Ants: Spray trails, nests and points of entry. Spray on Ants where possible. Repeat as necessary.

Carpet Beetles: Spray directly on Beetles, floors, baseboards, shelves and carpets. Repeat treatment as necessary.

Bedbugs: Spray mattresses, particularly around tufts and seams. Take beds apart and spray into all joints. Treat baseboards, moldings and floors. Repeat treatment as necessary.

To control Clothes Moths and Carpet Beetles on wool and other proteinaceous fibers: Remove infested articles from storage, brush thoroughly, and air for several hours in sunlight, if possible. Apply spray liberally to empty chests, closets, bureaus and other storages directing the spray into cracks Under joints and crevices. Store in a cool, dry area. Do not transport or store below 32°F.

Wrap container in several layers of newspaper and dispose of in trash. Do not incinerate or puncture.
