DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

For Household Use Only: For Use in Rooms, Apartments, Homes, Attics, Basements, Campers, Boats, Household Storage Areas, Garages, Pet Sleeping Areas, Cabins.

Permanone® Dusting Powder provides quick long lasting control of fleas and ticks on dogs.

INDOOR USE

Permanone® Household Dusting Powder is intended for applications with hand or power duster (Actisol® or similar equipment), with a paint brush or by other suitable means, to hiding and runway areas and other places where insects are found. To apply insecticide directly into crack and crevice, use a bulbous duster or other suitable equipment. Apply lightly and uniformly to infested areas.

Cockroaches (Including adult and immature stages of both non-resistant and organophosphate and carbamate resistant strains), Ants, Crickets, Silverfish and Firebrats: Apply thoroughly at a rate of 3 to 6 ounces per 100 square feet to all areas where these pests crawl and hide, especially in cracks and crevices, and hidden surfaces around sinks and storage areas, behind baseboards, around doors and windows, behind and under refrigerators, cabinets, sinks and stoves and in attics and crawl spaces. For ants, sprinkle freely around ant trails, doors and windows, and other places where ants enter premises around nests hidden under steps, brickwork, concrete, etc. Break apart accessible nests and scatter powder freely on and around debris. Repeat as necessary.

Brown Dog Ticks and Fleas in Buildings: Apply dust at a rate of 3 to 6 ounces per 100 square feet to infested areas such as pet beds and resting quarters, nearby cracks and crevices, under the edges of rugs and floor coverings, between and under cushions of upholstered furniture and other areas where these pests may be present. Old bedding of pets should be removed and replaced with clean fresh bedding after treatment of pet areas.

Spiders: Apply at a rate of 3 to 6 ounces per 100 square feet along and behind baseboards, to window and door frames, corners, pipes, storage localities, attics, crawl spaces and other areas over which these pests may crawl.

Sowbugs, Pillbugs, Ground Beetles, Earwigs, Millipedes, Centipedes and Scorpions: Apply at a rate of 3 to 6 ounces per 100 square feet around doors and windows and other places where these pests may enter premises. Treat baseboards, storage areas and other locations where these pests are found.

ACCEPTED

Wasp and Bees: It is general-ly returned to the next. Wear protective clothing to avoid stings. Using hand means with extension tubes for entrance and surrounding areas. Holes can be located by blowing a hole in the area, or by checking for the wasps' dust entrance and check nests carefully one or complete kill, then remove and of newly-hatched insects. If nest, if necessary. Do not use

Pantry Pests - Grain Beetles (toothed), Flour Beetles (Rice), Rice Weevils, Lesser Tobacco Moths: Treat exposed areas at a rate of 3 to 6 ounces per 100 square feet and under cupboards and apply directly on food, utensils

Carpet Beetles (Black, Fur): Apply at a rate of 6 ounces per 100 square feet to coverings, under rugs and furniture where these insects are found.

Bedbugs: Dust mattresses and bed frames, particularly around tufted areas, with dust into all joints. Treat as a spot treatment as necessary.

Webbing Clothes Moths: Use treatment in closets and other areas where they are found. This is an adjunct to treatment of larvae already on the clothes.

To Kill Fleas, Ticks and Lice: Apply dust to the entire body, beginning at the head and moving down the dust into hair and around the body by rubbing against the lay of the hair. Contact ticks with powder in animal's eyes, nose or sleeping areas, carpeting or animal's bedding. Repeat at weekly intervals.

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OUTDOOR USE

PERIMETER TREATMENT: Use Permanone® Dusting Powder as a residual treatment for control of *Ants, Bees, Brown Dog Ticks, Centipedes, Cockroaches, Crickets, Earwigs, Firebrats, Fleas, Ground Beetles, Millipedes, Pillbugs, Scorpions, Silverfish, Sowbugs, Spiders, Ticks and Wasps*. Make a residual treatment around windows and doors, porches, screens, eaves, patios, garages, under stairways and in crawl spaces and other areas where pests hide.

To help prevent invasion of buildings and structures by the above pests, treat a band of soil and vegetation 6 to 10 feet wide around and adjacent to the building or structure at a rate of 3 to 6 ounces per 100 square feet. Also treat the building foundation and crawl spaces where pests are active and may find entrance. Apply thoroughly and uniformly to the band area. Pay particular attention to ant hills and wasp nests in the band area. Wasp and bee nests in trees and shrubs may be treated as noted above.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate food, feed or water by storage or disposal.

PESTICIDE STORAGE AND SPILL PROCEDURES: Store upright at room temperature. Keep away from moisture. Sweep up and dispose of with chemical waste.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Pesticide that cannot be used according to label instructions must be disposed of at or by an approved waste disposal facility.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Completely empty liner by shaking and tapping sides and bottom to loosen clinging particles. Empty residue into application equipment. Then dispose of liner in a sanitary landfill or by incineration if allowed by State and local authorities. If drum is contaminated and cannot be reused, dispose of in same manner.

CONTAINERS ONE POUND AND SMALLER: Do not reuse container. Wrap container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS CAUTION

Harmful if inhaled. Avoid breathing dust. Avoid contact with eyes or clothing. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse. Take care not to introduce the product into the air during indoor application; use only in well ventilated areas. Do not apply where children are likely to contact treated surfaces. Remove or cover aquaria before application. Do not apply to surfaces or utensils which will contact food or feed.

Exposed food should be covered or removed during application. All food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during application or thoroughly wash with soap and water after use.

Do not apply product directly in/on eyes, mouth or genitalia of animals. Do not treat or cause exposure to puppies less than four weeks old. Do not use this product on old, sick, debilitated or pregnant animals.
