Permanone® Household Dusting Powder is intended for applications with hand or power duster (Actisol® or similar equipment), with a paint brush or by other suitable means, to hiding and runway areas and other places where insects are found. To apply insecticide directly into crack and crevice, use a bulbous duster or other suitable equipment. Apply lightly and uniformly to infested areas.

Cockroaches (including adult and immature stages of both non-resistant and omanophosphate and carbamite registant strains), Ants, Crickets, Silverlish and Firebrats: Apply thoroughly at a rate of 3 to 6 ounces per 100 square feet to all areas where these posts crawl and hide, especially in cracks and crevlces, and hidden surfaces around sinks and storage areas, behind baseboards, around doors and windows, behind and under refrigerators, cabinets, sinks and stoves and in attics and crawl spaces. Old bedding of pets should be removed and replaced with clean fresh bed 'ing after treatment of pet areas.

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OUTDOOR USE

PERIMETER TREATMENT: Use Permanone® Dusting Powder as a residual treatment for control of Ants, Bees, Brown Dog Ticks, Centipedes, Cockroaches, Crickets, Earwigs, Firebrats, Fleas, Ground Beetles, Millipedes, Pillbugs, Scorpions, Silverfish, Sowbugs, Spiders, Ticks and Wasps. Make a residual treatment around windows and doors, porches, screens, eaves, patios, garages, under stairways and in crawl spaces and other areas where pests hide.

To help prevent invasion of buildings and structures by the above posts, treat a band of soil and vegetation 6 to 10 feet wide around and adjacent to the building or structure at a rate of 3 to 6 ounces per 100 square feet. Also treat the building foundation and crawl spaces where pests are active and may find entrance. Apply thoroughly and uniformly to the band area. Pay particular attention to ant hills and wasp nests in the band area. Wasp and bee nests in trees and shrubs may be treated as noted above.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL
