TurboCide GOLD with Pyrethrins applied using apparatus of Fairfield American Corporation. Apply at an application rate not to exceed 1.4 mg of pyrethrins / m<sup>3</sup>, diluting as directed on the spraying equipment.

For optimum performance apply to all HVAC equipment. The application rate is 2 hours after treatment. Treatment rates are determined by the degree of infestation. To interrupt the life cycle of insects, application rates given below pertain to exposure periods are in excess of 24 hours. Application rates may be used.

For control of flying insects: *Moths*, apply TurboCide GOLD / 1000 ft<sup>3</sup> (1.4 mg of pyrethrins / 1000 ft<sup>3</sup> treated area).

For the control of crawling insects: *Beetles*, apply TurboCide GOLD / 1000 ft<sup>3</sup> (2.8 - 4.3 mg of pyrethrins / 1000 ft<sup>3</sup> treated area). Ventilate before reentry.
