- c. Since this is a Manufacturing Use Product it requires a special paragraph under Environmental Hazards and must be stated as follows:

---This pesticide is highly toxic to fish and other aquatic organisms. 3. We have reviewed the product chemistry data MRID No.421532-01 and have the following comments:

- a. In reference to the Confidential Statement of Formula dated November 21, 1991, the certified limits of PBO and Permethrin are reversed. The certified limits of Isopar M and Witcamide 511 are also reversed. Please make the necessary corrections.
- b. Your application states container sizes as one ounce to 55 gallons, therefore please provide, correct pesticide and container statement and contamination statement according to PR Notice 83-3.
- c. Update the Label Storage and Pesticide and Container Disposal Statements in accordance with PR Notice 84-1 for non-aerosol containers, for houses and institutional uses and/or PR Notice 83-3 for all other uses

4. In reference to the acute toxicity studies, the following toxicity categories and classification have been assigned to the product.

The skin sensitization study was assigned core minimum data since a naive control group was not included in the study.

You have requested a waiver for the acute inhalation study on the grounds that the product is a manufacturing use concentrate and the components of the formulation are known to have low inhalation toxicity and relatively low vapor pressure. The Agency grants the requested waiver for the acute inhalation study, based on the use pattern of this particular product, since it poses minimal inhalation hazard. This however, will not necessarily apply to the end-use products formulated with it.
