DIRECTIONS: RAID Liquid Spray Flying Insect Killer is a space spray that knocks down quickly and kills flies, mosquitoes, small flying moths and gnats. Wetting by direct spraying kills roaches, ants, silverfish, fleas and bedbugs.

IMPORTANT -- USE AS DIRECTED:

Flies, Mosquitoes and Gnats -- Close doors and windows. Spray freely towards ceiling in all directions until room is fogged with mist. When spraying keep about two feet from interior walls, fabrics and furniture. Do not remain in treated areas and ventilate the area after treatment is completed. Doors and windows may be opened after 10 minutes. Sweep up and destroy fallen insects.

Roaches, Waterbugs and Silverfish -- Spray thoroughly and frequently into cracks and crevices, baseboards, door frames, book cases, storage areas, under and behind sinks, cupboads, drawers, woodwork, refrigerators, pipes and drains where these insects hide. Spray directly on as many insects as possible to achieve control. Repeat application as necessary.

Clothes Moths and Carpet Beetles -- Spray directly on these insects, their eggs and larvae to achieve control shelves, closets, furniture and areas under furniture, rugs and carpets, and woolen articles should be treated. In infested upholstered furniture, thoroughly treat interior and exterior of furniture. Both the top surface and underside of rugs and carpets should be treated. Clean and brush woolen articles, then spray thoroughly, especially seams and folds, holding sprayer about 18 inches from articles. Allow articles to dry completely before using. Repeat applications as necessary.

Bedbugs -- Spray baseboards, moldings, floor boards. Spray mattresses particularly arounds seams and tufts. Take beds apart and spray into all joints. Repeat application as necessary.

Ants -- Spray trails, hills, around window trames and openings around pipes, and baseboards where ants crawl, hitting as many as possible. Repeat application as necessary.

Fleas -- Spray 11.0rs, floor coverings, cracks, crevices, sleeping quarters of pets and i fested furniture. Spray directly on as many insects as possible and repeat application as necessary to achieve control.

CAUTION: Harmful if wallowed. Keep out of reach of children. Avoid contaminaton of footstuffs, dishes and utensils. Do not use on humans, pets or plants. Cover bird cages and fish bowls before using spray. Most asphalt tile, some linoleum and certain plastic materials have a tendency to discolor and to soften when wet with petroleum base insecticides. Before spraying, test such materials by applying to empty container. Destroy it by perforating or crushing. Bury or discard in a safe place.

Not for use on plants. For garden pests use RAID aerosol House and Garden bug Killer.
