- The Statement of Practical Treatment for ingestion must be changed to read:

IF SWALLOWED: Call a physician or Poison Control  
Center immediately. Do not induce  
vomiting because of aspiration  
hazard.

At your request, we reconsidered comment number 1 of our letter dated June 8, 1988 concerning the Statement of Practical Treatment for ingestion. The statement should read as indicated above.

Submit five (5) copies of the finished printed labeling before the product is released for shipment under this revised labeling.

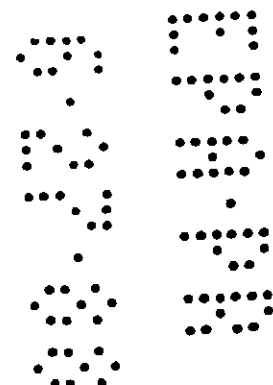

## BACK PANEL

### NEW UNSCENTED OFF! PRESSURIZED INSECT REPELLENT

HOLD UPRIGHT WHEN SPRAYING. Hours of protection from mosquitoes. Repels gnats, and biting flies, deer flies, sand flies, stable flies, black flies. Also repels ticks, chiggers and fleas from treated skin. The pleasant unscented formula is not greasy, won't stain, and resists perspiration. Most effective repellent ingredient ever developed.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Do not apply near food or to livestock.

Hold unit 6 to 8 inches from skin or clothing and spray with slow sweeping motion. FOR MAXIMUM PROTECTION, spread evenly with hand to moisten all exposed skin.

TO APPLY TO FACE: Spray palm of hand and spread on face and neck. Avoid contact with eyes and lips.

WORKS ON CLOTHING TOO: Spray shirts, socks, and hats. For ticks and chiggers also spray pants cuffs, socks and around opening in outer clothing. Will not damage nylon, cotton and wool. Should not be used on acetate, rayon, spandex, Dynel, or Verel fabrics. May damage furniture finishes, plastics, painted surfaces and watch crystals.

### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL STATEMENTS

STORAGE: Store away from heat or flame in an area inaccessible to children. DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash.

### PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS: CAUTION - Harmful if swallowed. Causes eye irritation. Avoid contact with eyes and lips. Do not allow children to rub eyes if hands have been treated. Do not apply to excessively sunburned or damaged skin.
