



# 2,4-D ISOOCTYL ESTER TECHNICAL

FOR FURTHER MANUFACTURING PURPOSES ONLY

ACTIVE INGREDIENT:

Isooctyl ester of 2,4-Dichlorophenoxyacetic acid\* 99.0%

INERT INGREDIENTS 1.0%

\*Equivalent to 65.66% 2,4-Dichlorophenoxyacetic acid

### CAUTION: Keep Out of Reach of Children

CAUTION: Causes irritation to eyes and skin. Do not get in eyes. Avoid contact with skin and clothing. In case of contact, flush eyes with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes and get medical attention. Wash skin with plenty of soap and water.

Do not use same equipment for handling or manufacturing other agricultural chemicals. Avoid contamination of domestic irrigation water supply. 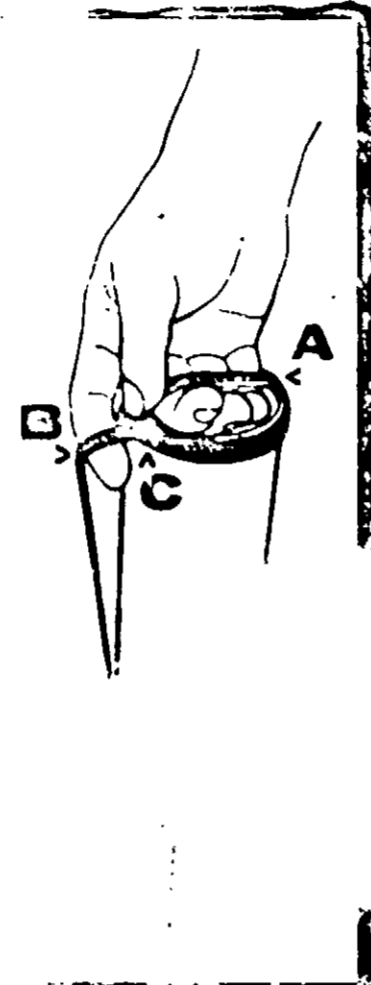

**DIRECTIONS**

1. Shake before use and occasionally during use.
2. Rotate nozzle D to unlock the trigger.
3. Place two or three fingers under handle strap A at bottom of container.
4. To lift trigger B, insert index finger between trigger strap and side of container.
5. Brace thumb against handle strap ring C
6. Aim at center of weed and pull trigger.
7. Do not overspray. A split-second shot from Weed Killer kills a medium-sized weed.



**IMPORTANT:** Do not spatter shrubs and desirable garden plants. For best results, apply on a warm day with no rain is expected for 6-8 hours and when weeds are growing vigorously. Weeds should die within 7-10 days. Some hardy weeds may require a second application. Avoid mowing for 2 days after use. Do not use on dichondra, clover, bent, carpet, St. Augustine or newly seeded areas, unless injury from spot treatment can be tolerated.

**CAUTION:** Avoid contact with eyes, skin and clothing. Avoid inhalation. Keep away from children. Protect crops from drifting mist. Contents under pressure. Do not set on stove, radiator or place where temperature exceeds 120° F. as container may burst. Do not puncture or throw in fire. Do not store near fertilizers, seeds, insecticides, or fungicides.
