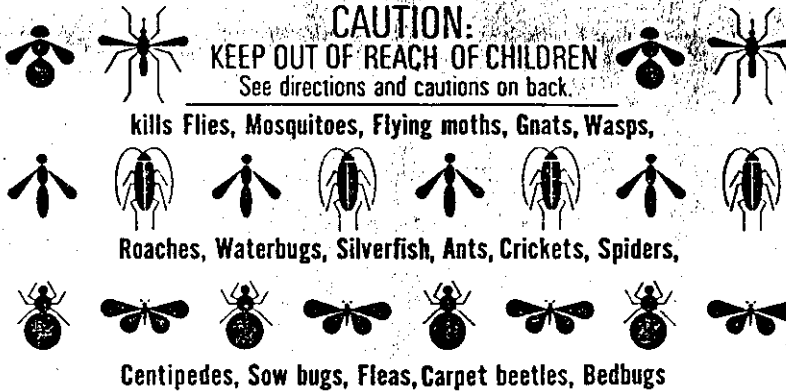

Don't waste Johnson's Buggy Whip. A little of this Raid product goes a long way! To Spray: Remove protective cap. Hold container upright. Point valve opening away from face and press button.

To kill flying insects: flies, mosquitoes, flying moths, gnats, wasps. With Johnson's Buggy Whip there is no need to spray directly at flying insects—the mist in the air will kill them. Close all doors and windows. Spray Buggy Whip up into the air with a sweeping motion, keeping about 3 feet from interior walls, fabrics, furniture and plants. Keep room closed 15 minutes. About 10 seconds of spraying clears 1,000 cubic feet. Ventilate the area after treatment is completed.

To kill crawling insects: roaches, waterbugs, silverfish, crickets. Spray hiding places such as baseboards and floor boards, moist places, openings around sinks, drains and pipes, behind bookcases, cabinets and other storage areas hitting as many insects as possible. Repeat as needed.

To kill ants: Spray trails, hills, around windows and sills and openings around pipes and baseboards where ants crawl, hitting as many as possible.

To kill spiders, centipedes, sow bugs: Spray webs and places where these pests crawl. Hit as many as possible. Repeat as needed.

To kill carpet beetles: Hit these bugs directly with spray on sections of floor, baseboards, shelves and carpets. Repeat spraying at frequent intervals.

DIRECTIONS (cont'd.)

To kill bedbugs: Spray baseboards, moldings, floor boards. Spray mattresses, particularly around seams and tufts. Take beds apart and spray into all joints. Repeat spraying at frequent intervals.

To kill fleas: Spray floors, floor coverings and sleeping quarters of pet. Repeat spraying as often as necessary. Do not spray pets.

CAUTION: Contents under pressure. Never puncture or throw container into fire. Never set container on stove, radiators or place where temperature will exceed 120°F, which may cause it to burst. Keep out of reach of children. Remove pets, birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying. Foods should be removed or covered during treatment. All food processing surfaces should be covered during treatment or thoroughly cleaned before using. When using the product in these areas, apply only when the facility is not in operation. Do not remain in treated areas. Ventilate the area after treatment is completed. Keep spray in constant motion at least 36 inches away from walls, fabrics, furniture, floor, plastics, etc. Spraying closer may cause stains or may damage certain floors or plastics.
