DIRECTIONS: SHAKE BEFORE USING
Point valve opening away from face and push button holding container as upright as possible.
DON'T WASTE RAID—A little goes a long way!

TO KILL HOUSE PESTS
For Flying Insects: Flies, Mosquitoes, Flying Moths, Gnats, Wasps. Close doors and windows and spray up into the air with a sweeping motion. Keep about 3 feet from walls, fabrics, furniture. Do not remain in treated areas. Ventilate the area after treatment is completed. 6 seconds spraying clears average size room (1000 cu. ft.).

For Crawling Insects: Roaches, Waterbugs, Crickets, Silverfish, Centipedes, Spiders, Sowbugs. Spray thoroughly into hiding places such as cracks and crevices, around pipes and baseboards. Hit as many bugs as possible. Spray top and undersides of rugs to kill Carpet Beetles. Repeat as necessary.

Ants: Spray trails, nests and points of entry. Hit as many bugs as possible.

Bedbugs: Remove bedding and spray mattress, seams, folds and other hiding places in bed and room. Repeat spraying at frequent intervals. **Fleas:** Spray floors, floor covering and sleeping quarters of pet. Repeat spraying as often as necessary.

TO KILL GARDEN PESTS (Listed On Front Panel)
Use spray with slow sweeping motion about 36 inches from all plants. Avoid wetting—a light spray kills pests effectively. Spray garden plants only when air is still. Spray in short bursts. Repeat application from time to time as long as insects are present. Use with caution on tender foliage, young plants and new growth.

WARNING • FLAMMABLE! Contents under pressure. Do not use near fire, sparks or flame. Do not set or store on stove, radiators or places where temperature may exceed 120°F, which may cause container to burst. Do not puncture or throw container into fire.

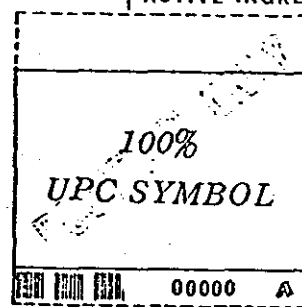
