The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. Five copies of the finished labeling must be submitted prior to releasing the product for shipment.

- 1) We note the addition of the sentence "Do not keep product on any longer then necessary". We believe this statement only partially complies with the intent of PR Notice 91-4. Add the phrase "After returning indoors, wash treated skin with soap and water".
- 2) Add the phrase "Use just enough repellent to cover exposed skin".
- 3) This label uses the signal word "WARNING". Change the beginning of the precautionary statements section to read "HAZARDS TO HUMANS -WARNING: May cause eye injury. Harmful if swallowed". Leave the remainder of the section as is.
