CAUTION: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN
(SEE DIRECTIONS AND CAUTIONS ON BACK)

CHILD GUARD CAP TO SPRAY, remove tamper proof tab on front of spray cap. Look into hole on top of cap and turn cap until white mark appears. To LOCK, turn cap until white mark disappears.

DIRECTIONS: SHAKE BEFORE USING

Point spray nozzle away from face and push button, holding container as upright as possible.

TO KILL HOUSE PESTS

FLYING INSECTS: Flies, Mosquitoes, Small Flying Moths, Gnats, Wasps. Close doors and windows and spray up into the air with a sweeping motion. Keep about 3 feet from walls, fabrics, furniture. Fill the room with mist. Keep room closed 15 minutes. Sweep up and destroy fallen insects. Repeat treatment as necessary.

CRAWLING INSECTS: Roaches, Waterbugs, Crickets, Silverfish, Centipedes, Spiders, Sowbugs. Spray thoroughly into hiding places such as cracks and crevices, around pipes and baseboards. Hit as many bugs as possible. Spray top and undersides of rugs to kill Carpet Beetles. Repeat as necessary.

ANTS: Spray trails, nests and points of entry. Hit as many bugs as possible.

FLEAS: Spray floors, floor covering and sleeping quarters of pet. Repeat spraying as often as necessary.

TO KILL GARDEN PESTS

(Listed on Front Panel)

Spray with slow sweeping motion about 36 inches from all plants. Avoid wetting — a light spray kills pests effectively. Spray garden plants only when air is still. Spray in short bursts. Repeat application from time to time as long as insects are present. Use with caution on tender foliage, young plants and new growth. Do not spray plants when temperature exceeds 90° F.

DISPOSAL

Do not use empty container. Wrap container and put in trash collection.

HAZARDS TO HUMANS

(& DOMESTIC ANIMALS)

CAUTION

Keep out of reach of children. Do not remain in enclosed areas after use. Ventilate enclosed areas before returning. Avoid contamination of food and food stuffs. Remove pets, birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Contents under pressure. Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 120° F. may cause bursting.

ACTIVE INGREDIENTS: Pyrethrins, 0.170%; technical piperonyl butoxide, 1.050% (equivalent to 0.840% of (butylcarbutyl) (5-propylpiperonyl) ether and 0.210% related compounds); Tetra-methion, 5-(1-cyclohexene-1, 2-dicarboximido) methyl-2, 2-dimethyl-3-(2-methylpropenyl) cyclopropane carboxylate, 0.070% and 0.014% related compounds, pentamethyl diisole, 0.006%.

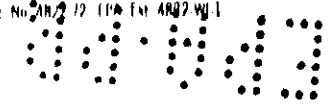
