DIRECTIONS FOR USE

SHAKE BEFORE USING: Holding container as upright as possible, point actuator opening away from face and push button.

TO KILL HOUSEHOLD PESTS

FOR FLYING INSECTS: To kill houseflies, mosquitoes, small flying moths, gnats. Close all doors and windows. Point nozzle upward. Direct spray mist to all parts of the room especially windows and other light sources which attract these insects. Fill room with mist then leave the treated areas. Keep the room closed for at least 15 minutes. Ventilate the room when treatment is completed.

TO KILL WASPS: Spray directly on stray wasps that enter buildings.

FOR CRAWLING INSECTS: To kill roaches, waterbugs, crickets, silverfish, centipedes, spiders, sowbugs. Hold dispenser about 12 inches from surface being sprayed. Spray thoroughly into hiding places such as cracks, crevices, moist areas, openings around pipes, and sinks, under refrigerators, baseboards and storage areas. Spray directly on insects where possible.

CARPET BEETLES: Spray top and underside of rugs. Repeat as necessary.

ANTS: Spray trails, nest, doors, and window frames where ants enter. Spray on ants where possible. Repeat as necessary Repeat as necessary.

FLEAS: Spray floors, floor coverings and sleeping quarters of pets. Repeat spraying as often as necessary.

TO KILL GARDEN PESTS & PROTECT ORNAMENTAL PLANTS
(listed on front panel)

Spray garden plants when air is still and temperature is not above 90 F. Spray with a slow sweeping motion about 36 inches from all plants. Avoid wetting - a light spray kills pests effectively. Spray in short bursts. Repeat application from time to time as long as insects are present. Use with caution on tender foilage, young plants, and new growth. For adult Whiteflies, Red Spider Mites, Gypsy Moths, and Japanese Beetles be sure to direct spray to contact these pests. Thoroughly cover the infested area. Repeat applications as necessary.

STORAGE: Store away from heat, spraks, and open flame in an area inaccessible to children.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash.
