DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

SHAKE BEFORE USING: Holding container as upright as possible, point actuator opening away from face and push button.

TO KILL HOUSEHOLD PESTS

FOR FLYING INSECTS: To kill houseflies, mosquitoes, small flying moths, gnats. Close all doors and windows. Point nozzle upward. Direct spray mist to all parts of the room especially toward windows and other light sources which attract these insects. Fill room with mist then leave the treated areas. Keep the room closed for at least 15 minutes. Ventilate the room when treatment is completed.

TO KILL WASPS: Spray directly on stray wasps that enter buildings.

FOR CRAWLING INSECTS: To kill roaches, waterbugs, crickets, silverfish, centipedes, spiders, sowbugs. Hold dispenser about 12 inches from surface being sprayed. Spray thoroughly into hiding places such as cracks, crevices, moist areas, openings around pipes, and sinks, under refrigerators, baseboards and storage areas. Spray directly on insects where possible.

CARPET BEETLES: Spray top and underside of rugs. Repeat as necessary.

ANTS: Spray trails, nest, doors, and window frames where ants enter. Spray on ants where possible. Repeat as necessary.

FLEAS: Spray floors, floor coverings and sleeping quarters of pets. Repeat spraying as often as necessary.

TO KILL GARDEN PESTS & PROTECT ORNAMENTAL PLANTS

(listed on front panel)

Spray garden plants when air is still and temperature is not above 90° F. Spray with a slow, sweeping motion about 36 inches from all plants. Avoid wetting - a light spray kills pests effectively. Spray in short bursts. Repeat application from time to time as long as insects

are present. Use with caution on tender foliage, young plants, and new growth. For adult Whiteflies, Red Spider Mites, Gypsy Moths Larvae and Japanese Beetles be sure to direct spray to contact these pests. Thoroughly cover the infested area. Repeat applications as necessary.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL STATEMENTS

STORAGE: Store away from heat, sparks, and open flame in an area inaccessible to children.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION : Harmful if inhaled or absorbed through the skin. Keep out of reach of children. Avoid breathing spray mist. Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing. Do not remain in enclosed areas during treatment. Ventilate enclosed areas before returning. Avoid contamination of food and foodstuffs. Cover and turn off fish aquariums. Remove pets, and birds before using. Wash hands thoroughly with soap and water after handling.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

If inhaled: Remove to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated.

If in eyes: Flush with plenty of water. If irritation persists, seek medical attention.

If on skin: Remove with soap and water. If irritation persists, seek medical attention.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Contents under pressure. Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130 F. may cause bursting.


