FLEAS: Remove soiled pet bedding and clean thoroughly or launder. Spray sleeping quarters of pets, around baseboards, windows, door frames, wall cracks and floors. Spray rugs and carpets where flea infestations are bad. Repeat as necessary. Put fresh bedding in pet quarters after spray has dried. For best results pets should be treated before allowing them to return to treated area. If used on light or delicate upholstery fabrics, test in an inconspicuous place prior to use. Use Flea Killer in conjunction with Raid Insect Fogger for particularly heavy flea infestations and for a complete flea protection program.

FLEAS ON PETS: To control fleas on cats and dogs, hold can upright, 10-12 inches from the pet. Starting at the tail, stroke against the lay of the hair spraying the pet's fur directly behind the hand to insure penetrating the coat. Spray to slightly dampen all areas of the fur. Avoid spraying the animal's head. Do not treat kittens or puppies under 6 weeks old. Repeat as necessary.

ROACHES, SILVERFISH, CRICKETS: Spray hiding places such as baseboards and pipes, behind bookshelves, cabinets and other storage areas hiding as many insects as possible. Repeat as necessary.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash collection.
