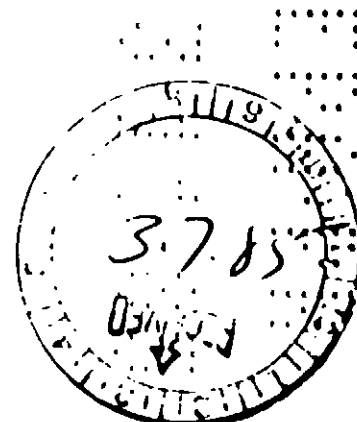
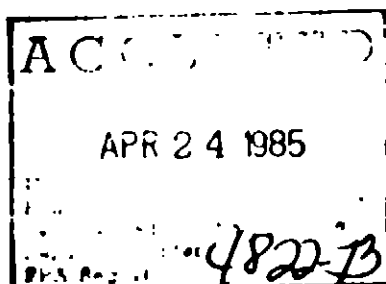

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE:** It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Shake can before using. Hold container upright. Point valve opening away from face and press button.

#### To Kill Flying Insects

**HOUSEFLIES, MOSQUITOES, SMALL FLYING MOTHS, WASPS:** There is no need to spray directly at flying insects. Spray up into the air with a sweeping motion, keeping about 3 feet from interior walls, fabrics, furniture, until room is filled with mist. Keep room closed for 15 minutes. Ventilate room before reentering. Sweep up and destroy fallen insects. Repeat treatment as necessary.

#### To Kill Crawling Insects

**FLEAS (and Ticks):** Remove soiled pet bedding and clean thoroughly or destroy. Spray sleeping quarters of pets, around baseboards, windows, door frames, wall cracks and floors. Spray rugs and carpets where flea infestations are bad. Repeat as necessary. Put fresh bedding in pet quarters after spray has dried. For best results pets should be treated before allowing them to return to treated area. If used on light or delicate upholstery fabrics, test in an inconspicuous place prior to use. Use Raid Flea (and Tick) Killer in conjunction with Raid Fogger for particularly heavy flea infestations and for a complete flea (and tick) protection program.

**FLEAS (and Ticks) ON PETS:** To control fleas (and ticks) on cats and dogs; hold can upright about 10-12 inches from pet. Spray to lightly dampen the animal's coat up to the head. For long-haired pets ruffle the coat and spray against the lay of the hair, spraying directly behind the hand so that spray reaches the skin. Rub into animal's coat to assure even coverage. Use fingers to rub product around eyes, mouth and ears. Do not spray head, genital-anal area or open wounds. DO NOT OVER APPLY. Reapply weekly or as necessary. Do not treat or cause exposure of animals under six weeks old. Some animals may be sensitive to this product. If adverse reactions occur, bathe the animal immediately. If symptoms persist, contact a veterinarian. (For best results in controlling tick infestations, spray ticks directly.)

**ROACHES, SILVERFISH, CRICKETS:** Spray hiding places such as baseboards and pipes, behind bookcases, cabinets and other storage areas hitting as many insects as possible. Repeat as necessary.

**ANTS:** Spray trails, hills, around window frames and openings, around pipes and baseboards where ants crawl, hitting as many as possible. Repeat as necessary.

**SPIDERS, CENTIPEDES, SOWBUGS:** Spray webs and places where these pests crawl. Hit as many as possible.

**CARPET BEETLES:** Hit these bugs directly with spray on sections of floor, baseboards, shelves, and underside of carpets. Repeat spraying at frequent intervals.

**STORAGE:** Store in an area inaccessible to children.

**DISPOSAL:** Discard container in trash.

#### **PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS**

**HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS - CAUTION:** Keep out of reach of children. Wash hands after treating pets. Do not remain in enclosed areas after use. Ventilate enclosed areas before returning. Avoid contamination of food and foodstuffs. When spraying rooms, rugs and carpets, remove pets, birds, and cover and turn off fish aquariums.

#### **PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS**

Contents under pressure. Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 120°F. may cause bursting.
