The confidential statement of formula for the basic formulation referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable. The confidential statement of formula for the basic formulation (dated February 5, 1996) supersedes the previous confidential statement of formula for the basic formulation (dated January 30, 1990).

The confidential statement of formula for the alternate formulation referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable. The confidential statement of formula for the alternate formulation (dated February 5, 1996) supersedes the previous confidential statement of formula for the alternate formulation (dated November 28, 1995).

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the following comments:

1. The term "new formula" may only be used for one year after acceptance of the alternate formulation. The Agency originally accepted the alternate formulation on December 1, 1995.
2. The statements "Kills with Pyrethrins" and "Pyrethrin insecticide is made from flowers" will be re-evaluated during the reregistration process. Such statements may be determined to be unacceptable and could be considered implied safety claims.

NEW FORMULA RAID FLYING INSECT KILLER

New Formula Raid Flying Insect Killer is designed for use whenever a flea (bug) infestation(s) occur(s) in your house. (For a complete flea and tick protection program, or for particularly heavy flea infestations, use New Formula Raid Flying Insect Killer in conjunction with Raid Roach and Flea Fogger.) (Use New Formula Raid Flying Insect Killer in conjunction with Raid Fogger for particularly heavy flea infestations and for a complete flea and tick protection program.)

(Twist and snap off tab before spraying.) (Picture)

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

SHAKE BEFORE USE. Hold container upright. Point valve away from face and press button. If used on light or delicate upholstery fabrics, test in an inconspicuous place prior to use.

FLEAS AND TICKS ON SURFACES: Remove soiled pet bedding and clean thoroughly or destroy. Spray sleeping quarters of pets, around baseboards, windows, door frames, wall cracks, and floors. Spray rugs and carpets where flea infestations are bad. Repeat as necessary. Put fresh bedding in pet quarters after spray has dried. For best results, pets should be treated before allowing them to return to treated area. If used on light or delicate fabrics, test in an inconspicuous place prior to use.

Use NEW FORMULA RAID FLYING INSECT KILLER in conjunction with Raid® Roach and Flea Fogger for particularly heavy flea infestations and for a complete flea and tick protection program.

FLEAS AND TICKS ON PETS: To control fleas (and ticks) on (cats and) dogs; hold can upright about 10-12 inches from pet. Spray to lightly dampen the animal's coat up to the head. For long-haired pets ruffle the coat and spray against the lay of the hair, spraying directly behind the hand so that spray reaches the skin. Rub into animal's coat to assure even coverage. Use fingers to rub product around eyes, mouth and ears. Do not spray head, genital-anal area or open wounds. **DO NOT OVER APPLY.** Reapply weekly or as necessary. Do not treat or cause exposure of animals under six weeks old. Some animals may be sensitive to this product. If adverse reactions occur, bathe the animal immediately. If symptoms persist, contact a veterinarian. (For best results in controlling tick infestations, spray ticks directly.)

ROACHES, SILVERFISH, CRICKETS:

Spray hiding places such as baseboards and pipes, behind bookcases, cabinets and other storage areas hitting as many insects as possible. Repeat as necessary.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in area inaccessible to children.

DISPOSAL: Discard container in trash.

[Per PR Notice 94-2 the following Disposal statement, or a variation which does not alter its intent, may be used:

DISPOSAL: This container may be recycled in the few but growing number of communities where steel aerosol can recycling is available. Before offering for recycling, empty the can by using the product according to the label. (DO NOT PUNCTURE!) If recycling is not available, wrap the container and discard in trash.]

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION: Harmful if absorbed through the skin. Keep out of reach of children. Avoid contact with skin, eyes, and clothing. Do not remain in enclosed areas after use. Wash hands thoroughly with soap and water after handling and after treating pets. Ventilate enclosed areas before returning. Avoid contamination of food and foodstuffs. Cover and turn off fish aquariums. When spraying rooms, rugs and carpets, remove plants, pets, and birds.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT:

If on skin: Remove with soap and water. If irritation persists, seek medical attention.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS: Contents under pressure. Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130 °F. may cause bursting.
