Hi, Sherada, hope this letter finds you well.

I'm sending along an 8570-1 form and a copy of the master label for the subject product, in order to notify the Agency of a correction to the subject label, to add "Sold By" before the company name and address, per 40 CFR 156.10(c). Although not specifically mentioned in PR 98-10 I am hopeful that this can be handled as a simple correction of erroneously omitted text.

This notification is consistent with the provisions of PR Notice 98-10 and EPA regulations at 40 CFR 152.46, and no other changes have been made to the labeling or confidential statement of formula of this product. I understand that it is a violation of 18 U.S.C. Sec. 1001 to willfully make any false statement to EPA. I further understand that if this notification is not consistent with the terms of PR Notice 98-10 and 40 CFR 152.46, this product may be in violation of FIFRA and I may be subject to enforcement action and penalties under sections 12 and 14 of FIFRA.

Spray rugs and carpets where flea infestations are bad. Repeat as necessary. Put fresh bedding in pet quarters after spray has dried. For best results, pets should be treated before allowing them to return to treated area. If used on light or delicate fabrics, test in an inconspicuous place prior to use.

FLEAS AND TICKS ON PETS: Read entire label before each use. Use only on dogs (and cats). Consult a veterinarian before using this product on debilitated, aged, pregnant, or nursing animals.
