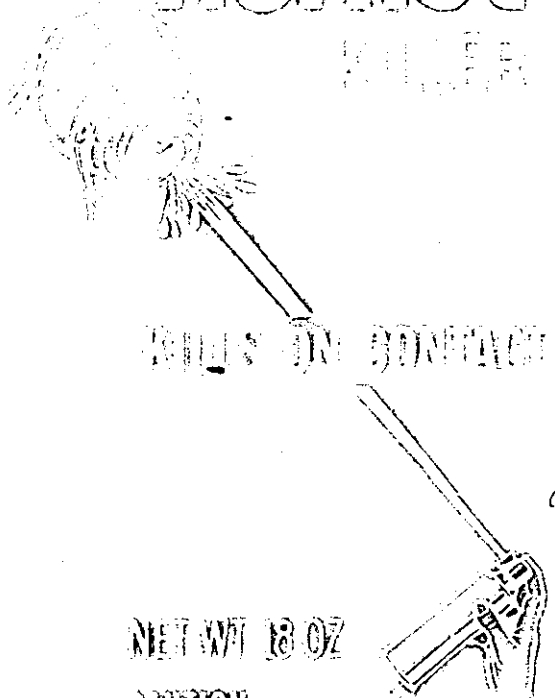

NET WT 18 OZ

CAUTION: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN
(See directions and cautions on back.)

Hold as upright as possible while spraying
RAID WASP and HORNET KILLER
 Kills wasps and hornets on contact
 Kills larvae and pupae in nests

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

1. Push down lock tab inside nozzle and remove.
2. Stand safe distance from nest (6 to 12 feet) and aim nozzle toward nest, with wind at your back. Spray until nest is thoroughly wet, hitting as many resting wasps or hornets as possible.
3. Best time to spray is early morning or evening, as wasps and hornets congregate in nests at night.
4. If desired nest may be removed 24 hours later.

CAUTION: Harmful or fatal if swallowed. Harmful if inhaled or absorbed through skin. If swallowed, induce vomiting. Get immediate medical attention. Atropine is antidotal.

Do not direct spray toward face. Avoid breathing spray mist. Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing. Do not smoke while using. Do not apply to humans, pets or contaminate feed, foodstuffs, dishes or utensils. Wash hands thoroughly after use and before eating or smoking. Keep out of reach of children.

Do not permit children to use or play with product. Eye contact with product which is emitted as a stream may cause severe discomfort.

Contents under pressure. Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Never set container on stove or radiator or place where temperature may exceed 120°F, which may cause container to burst. Do not puncture or throw container into fire.

For outdoor use only. Not a space spray... do not try to hit insects on the wing. Do not stand directly under nest. Avoid direct spraying on vegetation. Avoid excessive wetting of asphalt materials.
