Subject: Amendment - Label Update
Raid Ant & Roach Killer
EPA Registration No. 4822-111
Your Application Dated July 10, 1985

The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA) is acceptable, provided that you make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:

- 1) Delete "Kills even resistant roaches" or name the kind of resistant roach, e.g., diazinon-resistant roaches.
- 2) Delete the statement "Keeps on killing with residual action . . . , etc." or indicate the duration of control (we assume this is based upon efficacy data).
- 3) The terms "fresh, clean, pleasant scent, clean scent, easy on you" are misleading and negate and/or contradict required safety statements such as, "Harmful if inhaled, avoid breathing spray mist, provide adequate ventilation of area being treated," which presently appear on the labeling. Therefore, these statements should be deleted. You may wish to identify the masking odor such as lemon scent, pine scent, etc.

Submit five (5) copies of your revised final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment with the amended labeling.

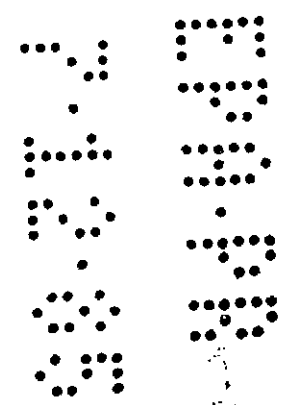

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DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

FOR HOUSEHOLD USE: Hold container upright. Do not spray up into air. Apply to surfaces only. Point spray opening toward surface to be sprayed and press button firmly. Hold about 12" from surface being sprayed. Spray until surfaces are wet. Avoid excessive wetting of asphalt, tile, rubber and plastic materials. Repeat treatment as necessary.

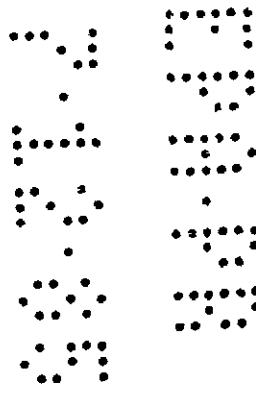
ROACHES, WATERBUGS: Spray until wet in cracks around baseboards and other hiding places. When bugs are driven out, spray directly.

ANTS: Apply to ant trails, also around doors, windows and wherever ants enter house.

SILVERFISH, CRICKETS, SPIDERS: Spray areas infested by these pests.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store away from heat or open flames, in an area inaccessible to children. **DISPOSAL:** Replace cap and discard in trash. Do not puncture or incinerate. Do not reuse empty container.

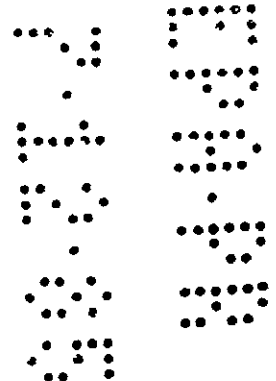
