1. Format the Ingredients Statement as follows:

*Contains Petroleum Distillates

2. Under Directions for Use, change "Hold container about 12" the surface being treated." to "Hold container about 12" from the surface being treated."

3. Add the heading STORAGE AND DISPOSAL before "Storage."

4. Under Directions for Use, change "Wash thoroughly with water after use." to "Wash hands thoroughly with soap and water after use and before eating or smoking."

5. The Note to Physician should appear at the end of the Statement of Practical Treatment.

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6. Under the Directions for Use, reinstate "For Household Use."

Submit five copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. A stamped copy of the labeling is enclosed for your records.
