DIRECTIONS FOR USE: Shake can well before spraying. Hold container upright.

To Kill Flies, Mosquitoes, Flying Moths and Gnats: Close all doors and windows and direct spray upward into center of room with a slow, sweeping motion. Spray 5 to 10 seconds for average room (1,000 cu. ft.) Keep nozzle three feet from surfaces. Keep room closed for 15 minutes after spraying. Ventilate room thoroughly before re-entry. Before spraying cover exposed food and utensils.

To Kill Roaches, Waterbugs, Crickets and Ants: Spray baseboards, cracks, crevices, moist areas and openings around sinks and pipes and other hiding places, hitting the insect directly. Spray ant hills and ant trails over window and door sills and other locations. Repeat as necessary for control.

CAUTIONS: Contents under pressure. Never set container on stove, radiator or places where temperature will exceed 120 F. which may cause container to burst.. Never puncture container or throw in fire or incinerator. Keep out of reach of children.
