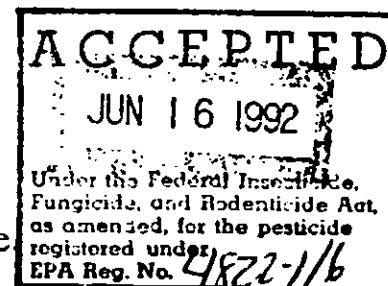
J-80 Sanitizer is expressly formulated for the effective sanitizing of food processing equipment and work areas which have been previously cleaned. It is recommended for use in all areas where meat cutting, food preparation and other food services take place in stores and in commercial restaurants and kitchens.

J-80 saves time and labor because no after-rinse is required when used at the recommended concentration of 200 ppm of active quaternary. J-80 may be applied with either mechanical or manual spraying equipment. See NOTE under Directions for Use for guidelines on sanitizer solution re-use. J-80 is effective as a sanitizer when diluted in water of up to 700 ppm hardness (as CaCO₃).

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

For sanitizing surfaces of food processing equipment and work areas in stores and in commercial restaurants and kitchens.

1. Clean all surfaces thoroughly with Johnson Breakup Cleaner. Tilt all movable surfaces for proper drainage. Rinse with hot water.
2. Mix 1-oz. J-80 Sanitizer with each gallon of water.
3. Wet surfaces thoroughly with J-80 solution.
4. Let surfaces drain and air dry. Do not rinse. Do not wipe



For sanitizing multi-use eating and drinking utensils in stores and in commercial restaurants and kitchens.

1. Scrape and pre-wash utensils and glassware whenever possible.
2. Wash with a good detergent.
3. Rinse with clean water.
4. Sanitize in a solution of 1 oz. of J-80 to each gallon of water (200 ppm). Immerse all utensils for at least 2 minutes or for contact time specified by government sanitary code.

- 5. Place sanitized utensils on a rack or drain board to air dry. Do not rinse. Do not wipe.

NOTE:

For manual operations: Change sanitizer solution daily. Periodically test sanitizer solution for a concentration of 200 ppm active quaternary by using the test kit available for this purpose.

For mechanical operations: The prepared use solution may not be re-used for sanitizing, but may be re-used for other purposes such as cleaning.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

STORAGE: KEEP FROM FREEZING - Store in cool dry area inaccessible to children.

DISPOSAL: (One gallon or less) Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash.

(Greater than one gallon) Do not reuse empty container. Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or incineration, or, if allowed by State or local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.

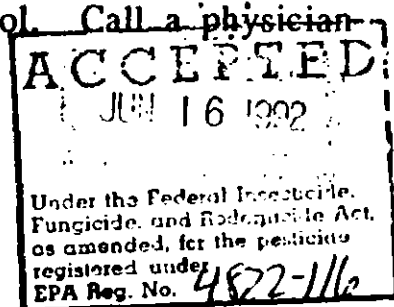
