Dear Ms. Geyer:

The proposed amendment to the registration for the product cited above under The Federal Insecticide, Fungicide And Rodenticide Act, as amended revising the label in response to the DEET RED and PR Notices 2001-1 and 2001-6 and making additional labeling changes is acceptable subject to the comments listed below:

- 1) Place the following statement in the First Aid section:

✘For additional information in case of emergency call toll free (Insert phone number).✘.

- 2) Delete all references to the 6 hour repellency duration claim. The data submitted to support these claims has not yet been reviewed. Once the data has been reviewed and if found acceptable, you can then request an amendment.

This product is not being re-registered at this time. Product specific efficacy data will be required. Once the efficacy guidelines are in place, you will be notified of the efficacy requirements.

Also, to meet the requirement of the DEET RED, the product must be packaged in containers utilizing a concave trigger to help aim the product or other comparable mechanism that will ensure that the product will not be inadvertently sprayed in the eyes.

A stamped copy of the amended label is enclosed for your records. Submit two copies of the final label before the product is released for shipment under this revised label.


The Confidential Statements Of Formula dated February 19, 2004 for the basic formula and alternate formula, 33495A are acceptable and have been placed into the file for this product.

Before the alternate formulas 33919A and 33496A can be considered, the following information on the inert ingredient, H & R 47455 D must be submitted:

- * Complete composition with chemical names, CAS Reg No. and percentages of each component.

FIRST AID

Have the product container or label with you when calling a poison control center or doctor, or going for treatment.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. **Read and follow all directions and precautions on this product label.**

Hold container 6 to 8 inches from skin or clothing and spray with a slow sweeping motion. **Do not apply over cuts, wounds, irritated or sunburned skin. Do not spray in enclosed areas. Use just enough repellent to cover exposed skin and/or clothing. Avoid over-application of this product.** Frequent reapplication and saturation are unnecessary. **Do not allow children to handle this product.** After returning indoors, wash treated skin with soap and water. **FOR MAXIMUM PROTECTION:** Spread evenly with hands to moisten all exposed skin.

TO APPLY TO FACE: Spray palm of hand first and then apply sparingly and avoid eyes. Do not spray directly onto face. Do not apply near eyes and mouth. Apply sparingly around ears. Do not apply to children's hands. When using on children, apply to your own hands and then put it on the child.

WORKS ON CLOTHING TOO: Do not use under clothing. Spray shirts, pants, socks, and hats. For ticks and chiggers also spray cuffs, socks and around other openings in outer clothing. Will not damage cotton, wool or nylon. Do not apply on or near: acetate, rayon, spandex or other synthetics (other than nylon), furniture, plastics, watch crystals, leather and painted or varnished surfaces including automobiles.

STORAGE: Store away from heat or flame in an area inaccessible to children.

DISPOSAL: Do not puncture or incinerate!
