Marketing Claims section comment(s):

- 1. In the 3rd and 5th marketing claims, delete the words "long lasting" since this claim is not supported by efficacy (product performance) data.
- 2. In the 12th and 13th marketing claims, replace the word "carry" with the word "transmit."
- 3. In the 14th marketing claim, replace the word "carry" with the word "transmit" and delete Japanese, Venezuelan equine and Murray Valley encephalitis since these diseases do not occur within North America.
- 4. Delete the 15th marketing claim since Ross River Fever, Barmah Forest Disease, Dengue Fever, Yellow Fever and Rift Valley Fever do not occur within North America.
- 5. In the 16th marketing claim, replace the word "carry" with the word "transmit" and delete European Tick Borne encephalitis since this disease does not occur within North America.
- 6. Delete the 17th marketing claim since Onchocerciasis does not occur within North America.
- 7. Delete all references to the 6-hour repellency duration claim. This claim is not supported by efficacy (product performance) data.

Directions for Use section comment(s):

- 12. The statement "Read and follow all directions and precautions on this product label." immediately below the statement "It is a violation of Federal law ..." should be revised to read: "READ AND FOLLOW ALL DIRECTIONS AND PRECAUTIONS ON THIS PRODUCT LABEL." This revised line of text should be CAPITALIZED and bolded to increase its prominence.
- 13. As required by PR Notice 2001-3, replace paragraphs 2, 3 and 4 with:

"Hold container upright about 6 to 8 inches from skin or clothing and spray with a slow sweeping motion. DO NOT spray in enclosed areas. Avoid breathing a spray product and DO NOT use it near food. DO NOT use as a space spray. Spray and spread evenly with your hand to moisten all exposed skin. Use just enough repellent to cover exposed skin and/or clothing. Use just enough repellent to cover exposed skin and/or clothing. Avoid over-application of this product. Frequent reapplication and saturation are unnecessary. Do not allow children to handle this product. After returning indoors, wash treated skin with soap and water. FOR MAXIMUM PROTECTION: Spread evenly with hands to moisten all exposed skin.

TO APPLY TO FACE: Spray palm of hand first and then apply sparingly and avoid eyes. Do not spray directly onto face. Do not apply near eyes and mouth. Apply sparingly around ears. Do not apply to children's hands. When using on children, apply to your own hands and then put it on the child.
