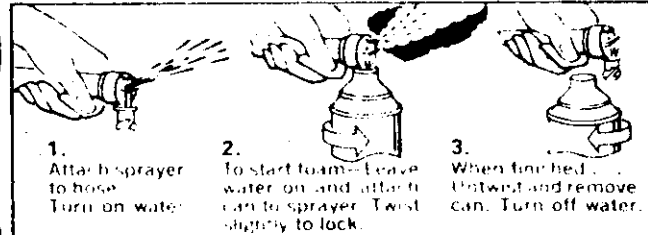

A unique way to kill insects (see chart) on shrubs, evergreens, trees, and flowers. Yard Master attaches to any garden hose. Its foam tracer shows where you have sprayed to insure complete coverage. No mixing no measuring—Yard Master is ready to use.

READ COMPLETE DIRECTIONS BEFORE STARTING
DIRECTIONS; HOW TO OPERATE



1. Attach sprayer to hose. Turn on water.
2. To start foam—Leave water on and attach can to sprayer. Twist slightly to lock.
3. When finished... Twist and remove can. Turn off water.

DIRECTIONS: HOW TO USE—Spray plants evenly with foam tracer. Apply to both sides of leaves and other areas of plants where insects are suspected. For dense evergreens and shrubs make sure spray reaches interior leaves and branches. Application will be more effective when air is calm. Do not spray when temperature is over 85°F.

Avoid spilling concentrated foam on grass or other plants. If spillage occurs, flush thoroughly with water.

PROBLEM AREAS	PESTS	NOTES
Roses and Flowers: Azaleas, Begonias, Chrysanthemums, Dahlias, Delphiniums, Gladioli, Iris, Marigolds, Pelonias, Roses, Salvia and Snapdragons	Non waxy Aphids, Mites, Leafhoppers and Exposed Thrips	Spray plants leaving a uniform light trace of foam, making sure to treat underside of leaves. Repeat application every 7 days until desired control is achieved.
Trees and Shrubs: Evergreens and deciduous shrubs	Non waxy Aphids, Mites, Leafminers, Tent Caterpillars, Flea, Webworms	Treat leaves and branches leaving a light trace of foam. Try to penetrate dense foliage. Repeat application every 7 days until desired control is achieved.
Nuisance Pests in Outside Areas	Ants	Apply hitting as many as possible. Spray trails and nests. Repeat as necessary.

CAUTION: Avoid spraying prepared foodstuffs. Avoid contact with skin, eyes, clothing. Keep out of reach of children.

WARNING: Contents under pressure. Do not puncture. Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Exposure to temperatures above 120°F. may cause bursting. Never throw container into fire or incinerator.
