**DISPOSAL:**

Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash collection.

**PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS**  
**HAZARDS TO HUMAN (& DOMESTIC ANIMALS)**  
**CAUTION:**

Harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through the skin. If swallowed, get immediate medical attention - Note to physician: Atropine is antidotal and should be administered only after symptoms appear. Avoid breathing spray mist. Do not apply to humans. AVOID contact with skin, eyes or clothing. Wash hands thoroughly with soap and water after use and before eating or smoking. Do not smoke while using. Keep out of reach of children, do not allow children in treated areas until dry. Do not use in edible product areas of food processing plants, restaurants, or other areas where food is commercially prepared or processed. Do not use in serving areas while food is exposed. Remove birds and cover fish bowls when spraying. Do not allow pets on treated areas until dry. Do not spray on plants or shrubbery.

**STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT**

IF SWALLOWED - Drink one or two glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Get medical attention immediately. IF ON SKIN - Wash promptly with soap and water. Rinse thoroughly. IF IN EYES - Rinse eyes for at least 15 minutes with water and call a physician immediately.

**PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS**

Foam can ignite. Keep away fro sparks, pilot lights, and other flames, both during use and after use, until foam disappears. Contents under pressure. Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 120 F. may cause bursting. Do not use on copper or brass.
