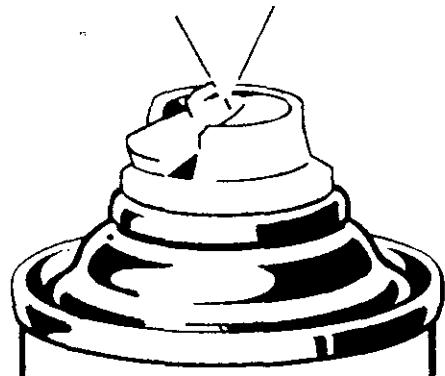

REMOVE or cover exposed foods, dishes, utensils, food processing equipment and surfaces. REMOVE pets and cover or remove fish tanks and bowls, and articles made of cotton Terry cloth. OPEN cupboards, cabinets, trunks, and floors to area to be treated. COVER asphalt tile, waxed wood floors and waxed furniture which may come in contact with the fog (Newspapers may be used.) CLOSE outside doors and windows. Shut off fans and air conditioners. EXTINGUISH all flames and pilot lights.

1. Place Fogger on stand or table in center of room with valve locked open, placing newspaper or pad under Fogger.
  2. To lock valve open. (1) Tilt sprayer away from face. (2) Press down firmly with thumb on sprayer tab until it snaps into place.

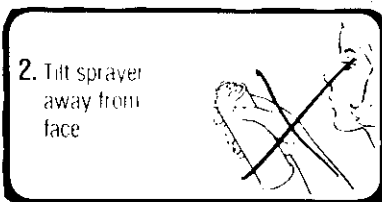
One can fills a room as large as 30'x25'x8'.

Nozzle lock is designed so that the spray will continue until the can is empty.

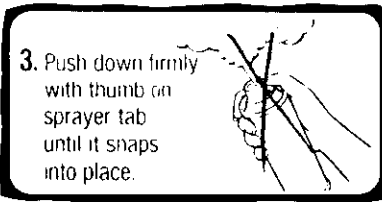

#### Directions:

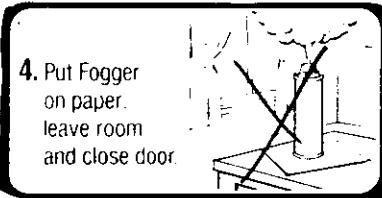
1. Place Fogger on stand or table in center of room with newspaper or pad under Fogger

3. Push down firmly with thumb on sprayer tab until it snaps into place.



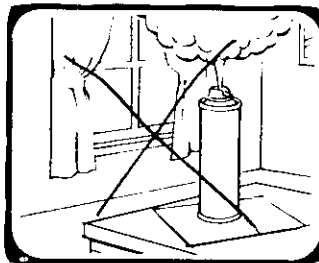
4. Put Fogger on paper, leave room and close door.
