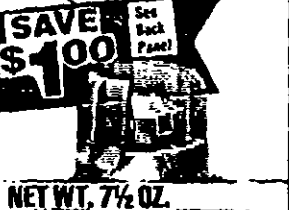

ACTIVE INGREDIENTS: Pyrethrin, 0.05%; Piperonyl butoxide, 1.00%; (equivalent to 0.00% of piperonyl butoxide); 2-(2-ethyl hexanoyloxy) carbonyl chloride, 1.00%; Propylene glycol, 11.00%

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS
CAUTION: Keep out of reach of children. Harmful if inhaled or absorbed through skin. Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing. Wash thoroughly after handling. Do not remain in treated areas after use. Stay out of rooms being treated for at least two hours. Ventilate treated area before reentering. Avoid consumption of food and beverages. All food preparation surfaces should be covered during application and thoroughly cleaned before use. Apply only when temperatures above 70°F. may cause burning. Do not spray on water containers or plastic.
STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT
If SMALL amount - do not allow vomiting. Get medical attention. NOTE TO PHYSICIAN - may present aspiration hazard.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS
FLAMMABLE. Contents under pressure. Do not use if valve near heat, spark, or flame. Do not puncture or otherwise damage. Exposure to temperatures above 120°F. may cause bursting. Do not spray on water containers or plastic.
DIRECTIONS: It is a violation of Federal law to use this product on a major restricted-use crop as labeled.

PREPARATION
To kill roaches, fleas, ticks, spiders, bees, mosquitoes, wasps, hornets, yellow jackets, silverfish, ants, gnats, earwigs, crickets, and small flying insects.
REMOVE or cover exposed dishes, silverware, food, clothing, equipment and surfaces. Remove pets and cover or remove up to 45 and 60 days. Close curtains, cabinets, doors and drawers to seal to be treated. COVER or seal wood floors and wood furniture in the immediate area surrounding the fogger. (No objects may be used to block multiple doors and windows. Shut off fans and air conditioning. (Exhaust fans and pull fans). Do not use sprayer on cabinet or under a curtain or lamp. Use only one can in rooms 12' x 12' or smaller.

STORAGE: Store away from heat, sparks and open flame. Do not allow accessible to children.
DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash.

OPEN BOX CAREFULLY VALUABLE COUPONS INSIDE

DIRECTIONS:

- Place newspaper on stand or table in center of room to be fogged.
- Break off and remove tab on side of sprayer.
- Tilt sprayer away from face. (Container sprays straight up.)
- Press down firmly with thumb on sprayer tab until it snaps into place.
- Set Raid Fogger on newspaper, leave room and close door.
- After actuating Raid Fogger, leave room or house at once. Keep treated area closed for at least two hours, then open all doors and windows and allow treated area to air for 30 minutes.
