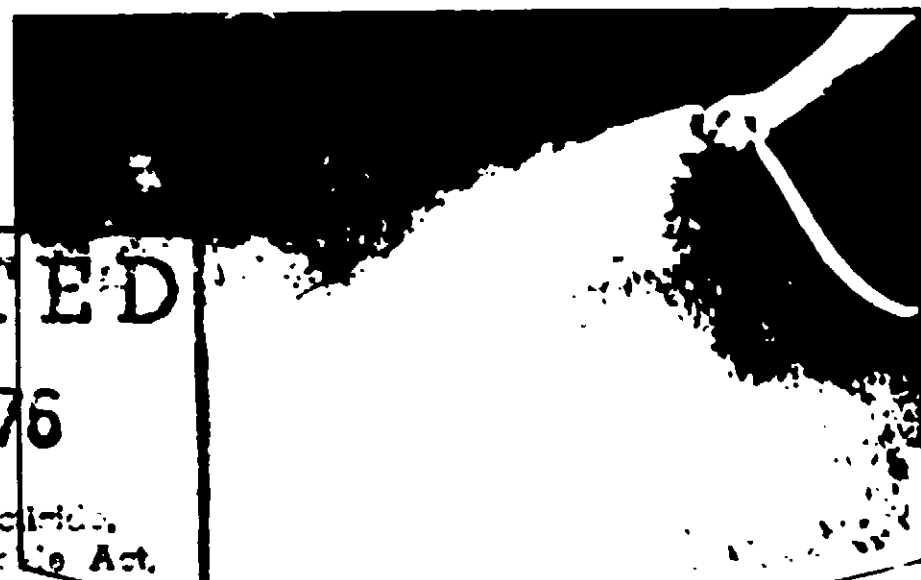

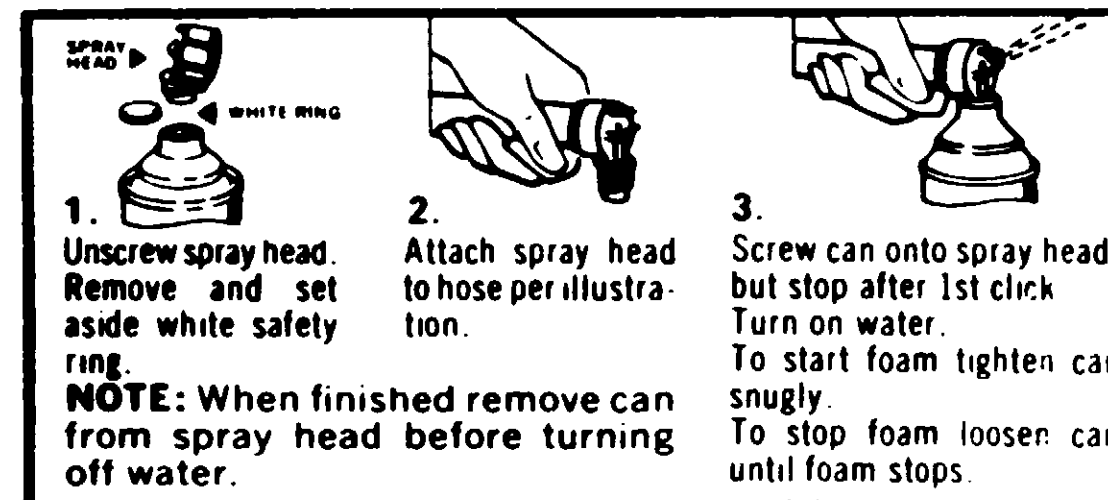

HOW TO OPERATE:



HOW TO USE: Spray plants evenly with foam tracer. Apply to both sides of leaves and other areas of plants where insects are suspected. For dense foliage, make sure spray reaches interior leaves and branches. Application will be more effective when air is calm. Do not spray when temperature is over 85°F. Repeat application every seven days or until desired control is achieved.

NOTE: Avoid dropping concentrated product on plants. If spillage occurs, flush thoroughly with water.
