##### HOW TO OPERATE:

1. Unscrew spray head. Remove and set aside white safety ring.	2. Attach spray head to hose per illustration.	3. Screw can onto spray head but stop after 1st click. Turn on water. To start foam tighten can snugly. To stop foam loosen can until foam stops.
NOTE: When finished remove can from spray head before turning off water.		

**HOW TO USE:** Spray plants evenly with foam tracer. Apply to both sides of leaves and other areas of plants where insects are suspected. For dense foliage, make sure spray reaches interior leaves and branches. Application will be more effective when air is calm. Do not spray when temperature is over 85°F. Repeat application every seven days or until desired control is achieved.

**NOTE:** Avoid dropping concentrated product on plants. If spillage occurs, flush thoroughly with water.
