READ COMPLETE DIRECTIONS BEFORE STARTING. Apply this product only as specified on this label.

HOW TO OPERATE:

1. Unscrew spray head. Remove and set aside white safety ring. **NOTE:** When finished remove can from spray head before turning off water.
2. Attach spray head to hose per illustration.
3. Screw can onto spray head, but stop after 1st click. Turn on water. To start foam tighten can snugly. To stop foam loosen can until foam stops.

HOW TO USE:

Determine the correct amount for your lawn area — do not over-apply or under-apply — one container covers 2,500 sq. ft. The spray should treat 20 sq. ft. in 5 seconds. Walk at a steady pace holding sprayer about 3 feet above the lawn. Spray lawn evenly — yellow foam tracer shows where you have applied product. For best crabgrass control, be sure to apply evenly and completely since crabgrass can grow in missed spots.

WHEN TO USE:

Apply in the Spring **before crabgrass germinates** (i.e. when lilacs begin to bloom.)

NOTE: Do not apply to new lawns started the previous fall. Wait six weeks after application before reseeding. Do not apply to newly sprigged areas until root growth is established. Do not apply to bentgrass or dichondra.

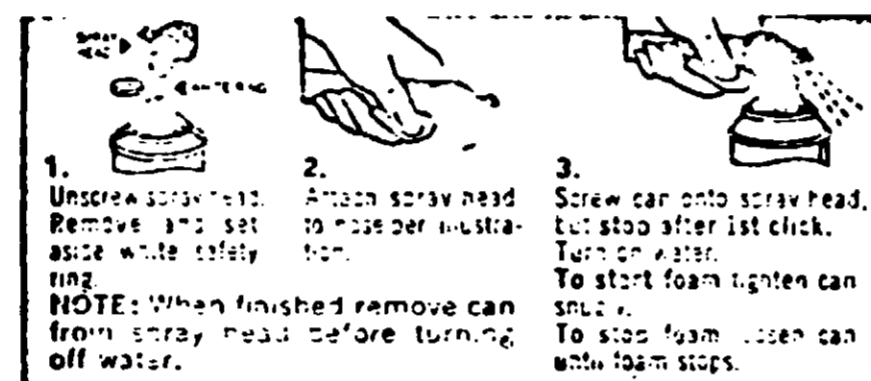
