Product 29 INSECT KILLER

A convenient way to kill insect pests in your vegetable garden (see chart below). No mixing or measuring, ready to use. At the first sign of insect pests, fog the garden areas affected. The spray penetrates dense foliage.

The insecticide ingredient in this product is natural pyrethrum.

CHILD GUARD CAP. To SPRAY, remove tamper-proof tab on front of spray cap. Look into hole on top of cap and turn cap until white mark appears. To LOCK, turn cap until white mark disappears.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE GENERAL CLASSIFICATION

IT IS A VIOLATION OF FEDERAL LAW TO USE THIS PRODUCT IN A MANNER INCONSISTENT WITH ITS LABELING.

HOW TO USE: Shake before using. Hold can on a slight downward angle. Spray plants from FOUR FEET away, allowing fog to drift through the plants reaching interior leaves and branches. Apply uniformly to garden, moving at a rate of about three feet per second. Application will be more effective when air is calm. Apply product at the first sign of pests. Repeat application every seven days, or as necessary for control. One container will treat three 20 ft. x 30 ft. gardens.

NOTE: Spraying closer than four feet may damage foliage.
