Contains natural pyrethrum insecticide.

CHILD GUARD CAP: To SPRAY, remove tamper-proof tab on front of spray cap. Look into hole on top of cap and turn cap until white mark appears. To LOCK, turn cap until white mark disappears.

Hold can on a slight downward angle. Spray plants from FOUR FEET away (spraying closer may damage foliage). Allow fog to drift through the plants and reach interior leaves and branches. Apply uniformly to garden, moving at a rate of about three feet per second. Application will be more effective when air is calm. Repeat application every seven days, or as necessary for control. One container will treat three 20 ft. x 30 ft. gardens.
