# TO KILL HOUSEHOLD PESTS

# FOR FLYING INSECTS:

To kill houseflies, mosquitoes, small flying moths, gnats. Close all doors and windows. Foint nozzle upward. Direct spray mist to all parts of the room especially windows and other light sources which attrack these insects. Fill room with mist then leave the treated areas. Keep the room closed for at least 15 minutes. Ventilate the room when treatment is completed.

To Kill Wasps: Applications should be made in late evening when insects are at rest. Spray liberally into hiding and breeding places containing as many insects as possible. Repeat as necessary. Spray directly at stray wasps that enter buildings.

# FOR CRAVLING INSECTS:

To kill roaches, waterbugs, crickets, silverfish, spiders, sow bugs, millipedes. Hold dispenser about 12 inches from surface being sprayed. Spray thoroughly into hiding places such as cracks, crevices, moist areas, openings around pipes, and sinks, under refrigerators, baseboards, and storage areas. Spray directly on insects where possible.

Spiders: Spray thoroughly at spiders and webbing and all cracks and crevices which harbor these pests. Repeat as necessary.

Carpet Beetles: Spray top and underside of rugs. Repeat as necessary.

Ants: Spray trails, nest, doors, and window frames. Spray on ants where possible. Repeat as necessary.

Fleas: Spray floors, floor covering and sleeping quarters of pets. Repeat as necessary.

# TO KILL GARDEN PESTS & PROTECT ORNAMENTAL PLANTS (Listed on Front Panel)

Spray garden plants when air is still and temperature is not above 90 F.

Spray with a slow sweeping motion about 36 inches from all plants. Avoid wetting -- a light spray kills pests effectively. Spray in short bursts. Repeat application from time to time as long as insects are present.

Use with caution on tender foilage, young plants and new growth.

For adult Whiteflies, Spider Mites and Gypsy Moth Larvae, be sure to direct spray to contact these pests. Thoroughly cover the infested area. Repeat applications as necessary.

#### DISPOSAL:

Do not re-use empty container, wrap container and put in trash collection.
