

#### FIRST AID

Have the product container or label with you when calling a poison control center or doctor, or going for treatment.

If in eyes: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes.

Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye.

Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

If swallowed: Call a poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice.

**Read all directions before using this product.**

Hold container 6 to 8 inches from skin or clothing and spray with a slow sweeping motion. Do not spray in enclosed areas. Do not apply over cuts, wounds, or irritated skin. Do not apply to excessively sunburned or damaged skin. Use sparingly on small children. Do not allow use by small children without close adult supervision. Use just enough repellent to cover exposed skin. Avoid overexposure. Frequent reapplication and saturation are unnecessary for effectiveness. Do not keep product on any longer than necessary. After returning indoors, wash treated skin with soap and water. **FOR MAXIMUM PROTECTION**, spread evenly with hand to moisten all exposed skin. Do not spray directly on face.

**TO APPLY TO FACE:** Spray palm of hand and rub on. Do not apply to eyes and mouth and do not apply to the hands of young children.

**WORKS ON CLOTHING TOO:** Spray shirts, pants, socks, and hats. For ticks and chiggers also spray cuffs, socks and around other openings in outer clothing. Do not apply under clothing. Will not damage cotton, wool or nylon. **DO NOT APPLY ON OR NEAR: ACETATE, RAYON, SPANDEX OR OTHER SYNTHETICS (OTHER THAN NYLON), FURNITURE, PLASTICS, WATCH CRYSTALS, LEATHER AND PAINTED OR VARNISHED SURFACES INCLUDING AUTOMOBILES.**

**STORAGE:** Store away from heat or flame in an area inaccessible to children.

#### DISPOSAL:

Do not puncture or incinerate!

Notification of Label Change per PR Notice 98-10**

Dear Ms. Edwards:

On October 22, 2002 S.C. Johnson & Son, Inc. submitted a notification for the subject product to add the following phrases:

Repels mosquitoes that carry West Nile Virus  
Repels disease carrying mosquitoes  
Repels disease spreading mosquitoes  
Repels mosquitoes that may carry diseases  
Repels mosquitoes that may spread diseases

In a letter dated November 15, 2002, you informed us that the submission did not meet the requirements of PR Notice 98-10 and would require further review by the Product Manager, Joe Tavano.

Since that time SCJ has had discussions with Joe Tavano and Marion Johnson. They have indicated that some, but not all, of our statements from the 10/22/02 submission would be acceptable to the Agency. They clarified that only certain specifically-worded phrases would be acceptable to the Agency, but that it was acceptable to add those statements via notification. Specifically, the statements we discussed are ***Repels mosquitoes that may carry West Nile Virus*** and ***Repels mosquitoes that may carry diseases***.

My means of this letter we wish to inform you of our intention to add those new statements to our product label. In accordance with PR Notice 98-10 we have enclosed a fully executed Application for Pesticide Registration and one copy of revised labeling. For your convenience revisions have been marked in ***bold Italics***.
