

## Raid INDOOR FOGGER

1. Place Fogger on stand or table in center of room with newspaper or pad under Fogger.

2. Tilt sprayer away from face.

3. Press down on top of sprayer to actuate.

4. Wait 30 minutes before reentering room.

5. After actuating Fogger, leave house at once and keep house closed for at least two hours before airing out. Open all doors and windows and allow treated area to air for 30 minutes.
