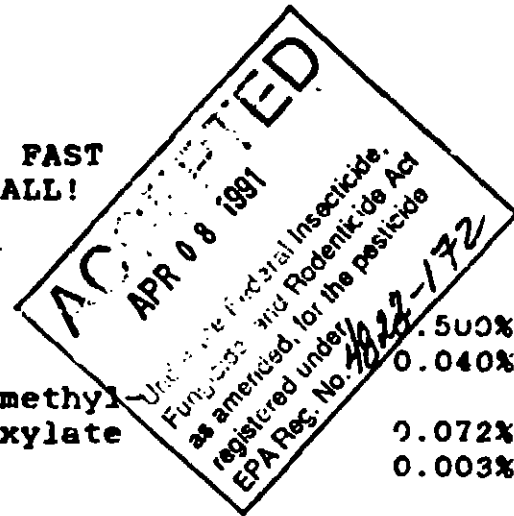

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF INHALED, remove victim to fresh air. **IF ON SKIN,** wash contaminated skin promptly with soap and warm water. **IF IN EYES,** flush with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This pesticide is highly toxic to fish. Do not apply directly to water or wetlands (swamps, bogs, marshes, and potholes). Drift from treated areas may be hazardous to organisms in adjacent sites.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Contents under pressure. Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 120 F. may cause bursting.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Shake before using. Hold container upright. Point spray opening away from face and press button.

HOUSEFLIES, MOSQUITOES, SMALL FLYING MOTHS, GNATS: Most effective when sprayed directly on flies. You can clear entire room in minutes by spraying upwards in sweeping movement (4 seconds for average room of 1000 cubic feet) staying about 3 feet from walls, fabrics and furniture. Keep doors and windows closed for 15 minutes. Do not remain in treated area. Ventilate after treatment.

ROACHES, WATERBUGS, SILVERFISH, CRICKETS. Spray hiding places such as baseboards and floorboards, moist places, openings aground skins, drains and pipes, behind bookcases, cabinets and other storage areas hitting as many insects as possible. Repeat applications as necessary.

ANTS: Spray trails, hills, around windows and sills and openings around pipes and baseboards where ants crawl hitting as many as possible. Repeat applications as necessary.

STORAGE: Store in an area inaccessible to children.
DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container, wrap container and put in trash collection.
