PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION

If swallowed, get immediate medical attention. Note to Physician: This product contains a cholinesterase inhibitor. Atropine is antidotal and should be administered by injection only after symptoms appear.

Do not apply to humans. Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing. Wash hands thoroughly with soap and water after use, and before eating or smoking. Keep out of reach of children; do not allow children in treated areas until dry. Cover and avoid spraying fish aquariums.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF SWALLOWED - Drink one or two glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Get Medical attention immediately. IF INHALED - Remove victim to fresh air and apply respiration if indicated. IF ON SKIN - Wash promptly with soap and water. Rinse thoroughly. IF IN EYES - Rinse eyes for at least 15 minutes with water and call a physician immediately.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This pesticide is toxic to fish. Keep out of lakes, ponds or streams. Do not contaminate water by cleaning or disposal of wastes.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Shake before use: Remove cap to expose sprayer. Hold container about 12 inches from surface being sprayed. Depress sprayer firmly. Spray until surfaces are slightly wet. For storage of remaining product replace protective cap.

INDOORS

COCKROACHES, WATERBUGS, FIREBRATS, SILVERFISH, CRICKETS, EARWIGS, SOWBUGS, CENTIPEDES, MILLIPEDES: Spray until wet in cracks, around baseboards, behind and beneath cabinets, refrigerators, sinks, stoves, around plumbing, and other localized areas infested with insects. Repeat as necessary.

ANTS: Spray until surface is wet, applying to ant trails, around doors and window frames and wherever ants enter the house. Repeat as necessary.

SPIDERS: Spray pests directly wherever possible. Apply to localized areas where infestations occur. Spray until surfaces are wet, particularly around windows, doors, baseboards and crawl spaces. Repeat as necessary.

CARPET BEETLES: Apply along baseboards, edges of carpeting, under furniture, under carpeting and rugs, in closets and shelving where infestations occur or are suspected. Spray surfaces until wet. Repeat as necessary.

FLEAS & BROWN DOG TICKS: Apply to infested areas such as pet bedding and resting quarters, around baseboards, door frames and wall cracks. Spray surfaces until wet. Old, soiled bedding of pets should be removed and replaced with clean, fresh bedding after spray has been allowed to dry. Do not spray directly on animal. Repeat as necessary. Additionally, treat pets with an EPA approved product registered for pet use.

FLIES, MOSQUITOES, SMALL FLYING MOTHS: For outdoor use only to aid in reducing annoyance from these insects. Spray outside surfaces of screens, doors, window frames or wherever these insects may enter. Spray light fixtures on porches, in garages and other places where these insects are known to alight or congregate.

FLEAS & BROWN DOG TICKS: For treatment of localized infestations outdoors, spray affected areas thoroughly. Repeat application as necessary and whenever reinfestations occur.

ANTS: Apply to nests and trails until surfaces are wet. Spray pests directly as they occur in infested areas. Repeat as necessary.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse container for any other purpose. Wrap container and put in trash collection.
