DIRECTIONS FOR USE: It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Not a space spray, apply as surface spray only.

Shake can before using. Point valve opening away from face and press button. This product is designed for applying to surfaces. Hold container 12-18 inches away from areas to be treated.

FLEAS: Remove soiled pet bedding and clean thoroughly or destroy. Spray sleeping quarters of pets, around baseboards, windows, door frames and wall cracks. Spray surface to slight dampness. Repeat as necessary. Do not spray animals. Put fresh bedding in pet's quarters after spray has dried. For best results, dogs and cats should be treated with a registered flea control product before allowing them to enter the treated areas. Use Raid Formula 36 in conjunction with Raid Indoor Fogger for particularly heavy flea infestations for a complete flea protection program.

ANTS: Apply to ant trails, also around doors, windows and wherever ants enter house. Apply as necessary.

ROACHES, WATERBUGS: Spray until wet in cracks, around baseboards and other hiding places. When bugs are driven out, spray directly. Repeat as necessary.

TICKS, SILVERFISH, CRICKETS, AND SPIDERS: Spray areas infested by these pests. Repeat as necessary.

CARPET BEETLES: Make localized application to areas of the floor and baseboards. Spray directly into cracks and under carpets where insects may be found. Hit as many insects as possible. Repeat as necessary.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash collection.

Harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through skin. PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS
