Shake Well Before Using FOR SPACE SPRAY APPLICATION: To obtain fine mist for use as a space spray, unscrew tip of nozzle approximately one complete turn. To dispense the product, squeeze trigger firmly. To prime, several pumps may be required before any liquid is dispensed.

FOR SURFACE SPRAY APPLICATION: To obtain a coarser spray for surface application, continue rotating nozzle until desired spray pattern is achieved.

FOR MAXIMUM SPRAY CONTROL: To direct spray into tight areas, continue rotating nozzle until product is dispensed as a jet stream.

TO KILL HOUSESHOLD PESTS FOR FLYING INSECTS: To kill Houseflies, Mosquitoes, small flying Moths, Gnats. Close all doors and windows. Adjust sprayer to fine mist as directed above. SPIDERS: Adjust trigger nozzle to coarse spray. Spray thoroughly at spiders and webbing and all cracks and crevices which harbor these pests. Repeat as necessary.

CARPET BEETLES: Adjust trigger nozzle to coarse spray. Spray top and underside of rugs. Repeat as necessary.

ANTS: Adjust trigger nozzle to coarse spray. Spray trails, nests, door and window frames. Spray on ants where possible. Repeat as necessary.

TO KILL GARDEN PESTS & PROTECT ORNAMENTAL PLANTS: (Listed on Front Panel) Spray garden plants when air is still and temperature is not above 90 F. Use with caution on tender foilage, young plants and new growth. Adjust trigger nozzle to coarse spray and spray with a slow sweeping motion about 18 to 24 inches from plants.
